Dresch Named Athlete Of Year



Some twenty-five citizens from the Manchester area will meet at the high school next Friday, March 18, at 8 p.m. to discuss the formation of a regional planning commission which will function as a local division of the county planning commission. The group will be addressed by Sanford S. Farness, director of the county body, who will suggest programs of study for the local body.

Though a planning commission is not a law-making body, its task is to undertake long-range studies of its region, make recommendations to township and village governments, and act as advisors to the lawmakers.
