# Member Tells Of 4-H Club Work

In observance of 4-H Week, Peter Spike, an ardent member for five years, wrote the following dissertation on 4-H which is most comprehensive. Peter is starting his fifth year of 4-H work and has had projects in sheep, dairying, crops and handicrafts.

Peter lives with his parents, Mr. and Mrs. Lowell Spikes on a 130-acre farm at 12051 Slocum Creek Road. Their dairy cattle number 50 head and Peter owns five of his own. His hobby is deer hunting and he has a 10-acre tract in the Fair and also in the Michigan State Fair, Junior Division. This is his first year of 4-H work and he has made a good record. It is evident that his 4-H is commendable.

A 4-H Club is a group of boys and girls living on a farm or in a rural community. It consists of five or more members between the ages of 10 and 20, inclusive. The club is supervised by the Extension Service of the U. S. Department of Agriculture as a part of its educational program and also by the agricultural colleges.

An individual member must do many things, too. He must understand one of the more than 30 various projects which are associated with farming and home-making. Another very important thing is keeping records. A record must be made of all income, expenses and the methods used. These records give the boy or girl training which will be valuable to him in life. Each member carries on his project under the guidance of an adult leader and must make a public exhibit of his project and turn in a report to the club leader who in turn gives it to the county agent.

"Fourth Club Week" is proclaimed each year by the President of the United States. During 4-H Week there are many special activities such as special programs, newspapers and magazines, and print articles about 4-H. This year 4-H Club Week was March 9 through 13 and the Ford Motor Company is featuring a motion picture and display at the Ford Road in Dearborn.

# FROM THE PULPIT Rev. Rest Discusses 'The Power Of Faith'
