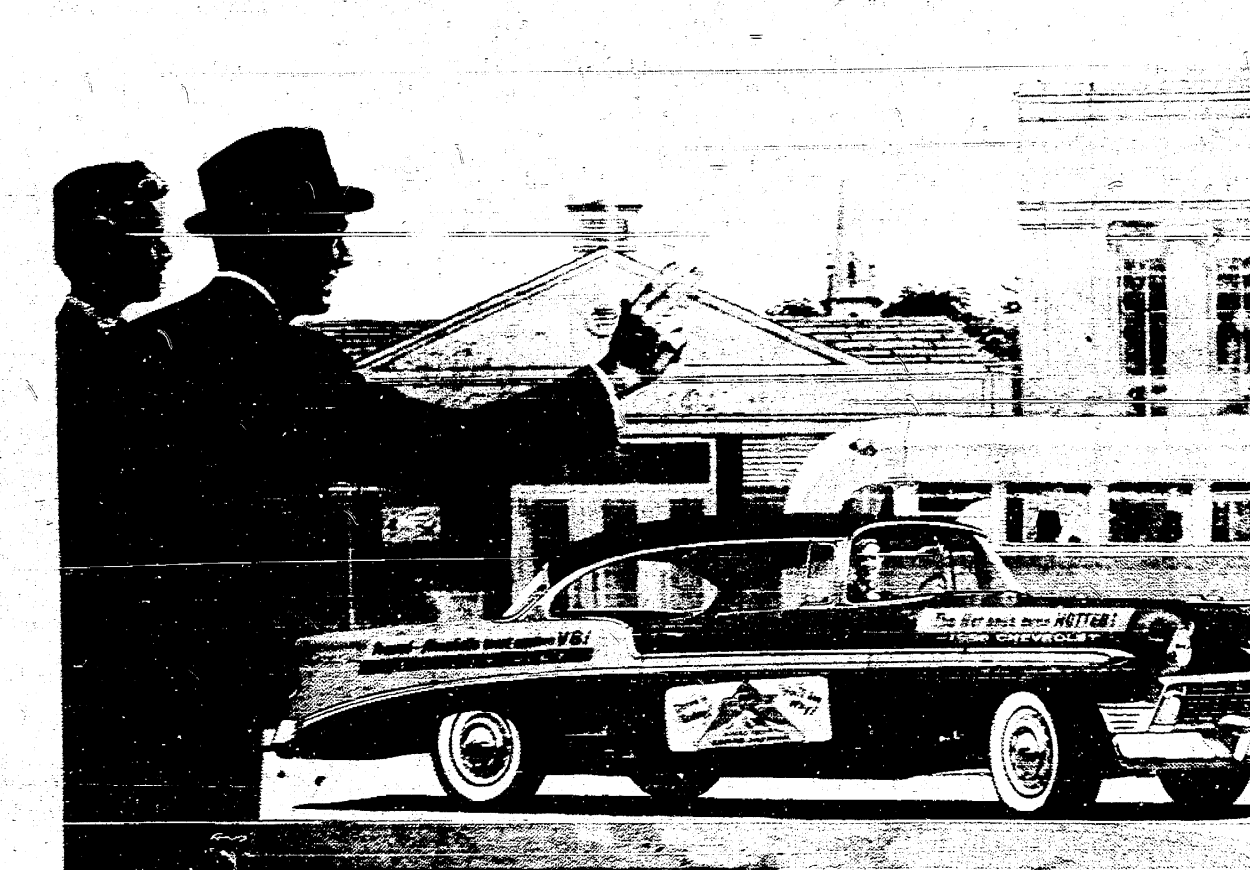

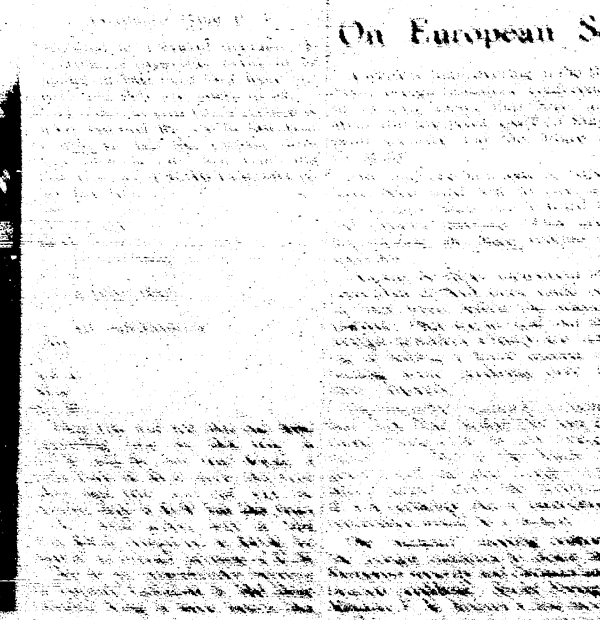

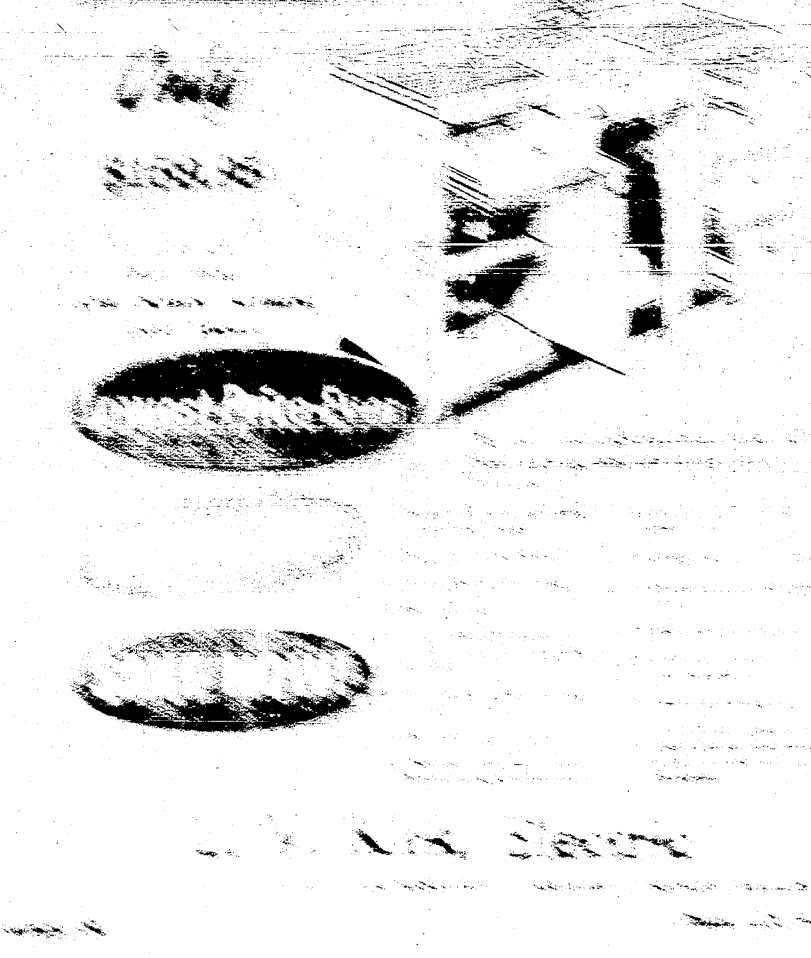

### Kefauver Committee Studies Miami Baby Adoption Racket

The Kefauver subcommittee on juvenile delinquency continues in Miami its study of an alleged baby adoption racket, with a view toward federal legislation regulating adoptions. A sort of federal Mann act aimed at the baby black market has been suggested frequently. Such proposals thus far have received little attention in Congress because family law is held to be within the province of the states. Bills introduced at the 1953 session by Sen. Edward J. Tamm, (R., Minn.) and by Sen. Estes Kefauver (D., Tenn.) and Sen. William Langer (R., N.D.) would have made commercial dealing in minor children a criminal offense. The bills proposed fines of up to \$10,000 and prison terms of up to five years. Only 15 states have criminal laws against baby selling. These states are Alabama, Arizona, Colorado, Delaware, Florida, Georgia, Kentucky, Maryland, Massachusetts, Michigan, Minnesota, New Jersey, New York, Ohio, Washington, and West Virginia. And whereas the Kefauver subcommittee has received testimony that black market baby traffic is carried on between the United States and Canada as well as between states, only Ontario and Saskatchewan of Canadian provinces have laws making baby selling a crime.

**No New Ruling Anticipated in Supreme Court on Segregation**  
The Supreme Court may have hesitated a couple of segregation cases this week. In any appeal to the high court from the ruling of a lower court, the lawyers on both sides state their arguments in writing. The justices of the Supreme Court get copies of these arguments. The lawyers can't walk up before the justices and argue orally. It is only when the justices want more information than is contained in the written arguments that they ask the lawyers on both sides to appear in court and speak their piece. In the 1954 Supreme Court decision on school segregation, which said Negroes could be kept out of public places reserved for whites, provided that the Negroes were kept separate, were given public facilities equal to those of the whites. This became known as the doctrine of "separate but equal." For half a century, the Supreme Court knocked it down. As a result, segregation continued in public schools and other public places throughout the South and in other states. But in 1954 the present Supreme Court unanimously wiped out the "separate but equal" doctrine in the case of public schools. That kind of segregation, the court said, was unconstitutional and must stop. But this ruling dealt with schools. Did the Supreme Court mean segregation was illegal in other public places, too? For instance, in parks and playgrounds? Already two test cases were moving through the lower courts. Maryland had segregated public parks and beaches. Georgia had segregated public golf courses. A Maryland court of appeals which the Supreme Court is now reviewing in that case, said it applied to parks and beaches, and ordered segregation in Maryland's public parks and beaches ended. But another U.S. Court of Appeals, one which covered Georgia, ruled that it was all right to have segregation on public golf courses. Both cases were appealed to the Supreme Court. The court considered the written arguments of the lawyers in both cases but called none of them to state their cases orally. It has heard long oral arguments in the school case. **Dignity Lost When Lincoln Rides Horse**  
In the eyes of at least one soldier of the Grand Army of the Republic, dignity went out the window when the President of the United States clambered aboard a horse to review the troops in November, 1960. In a letter, now in the Michigan Historical Collections at the University of Michigan, to a relative in Decatur, Mich., Charles B. Haydon, a second lieutenant in Company I of the state's 2nd Regiment, wrote letters to him and 45 letters from Nelson's naval colleagues in the Napoleonic wars, as well as a number of books. Items from the Smith Collection now being exhibited have been given the general title "Of Sea and Shore" and are divided into the following categories: Voyages and Ship Building; Voyages and Adventures; War of 1812 and Disasters at Sea; and the American Revolution; Admiral Nelson and his Friends; War of 1812 and Disasters at Sea. "The grand review must have been exceedingly interesting to the President. His horse had to go at a keen run. One hand hold of the bridle, the other convulsively clutched in the mane of his horse and a steeple as though he were determined to go through it killed him but would be most amazingly glad when it was over." The President, of course, was Abraham Lincoln. Lt. Haydon, who was in formation with regiment, added, "I would gladly have given \$10 to have been close so that I could have seen the whole spectacle."

### Speedup In Bowling Asked

The proprietors were expected to agree enthusiastically, according to W. W. Edgar, BPA executive secretary, to post copiously around the 125 BPA member alleys in the Detroit area notices signed by Cole urging bowlers to "Stop Right Up—And Stay Up," as he on the approach when it's their turn to bowl. Edgar said notices of the proposal had gone out to all alleys. Cole, captain of the "Citizens' Man" team in the West Side Classic and the Ward Mayor Classic, is the first active classic league bowler at least since 1941.
