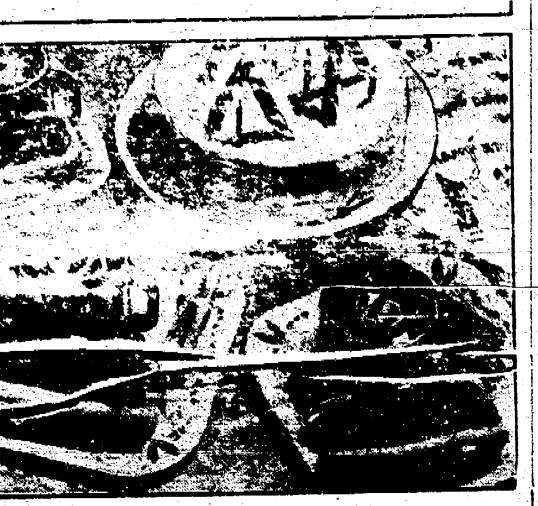

He has featured in the Washington County Polio Powder which was used in the successful campaign to raise money for the preparation and treatment of polio. Andy contracted the disease in August, 1934, and in December of that year, he was still confined to an iron lung. Andy, son of Mr. and Mrs. LeRoy Cappeert, 225 Fountain Street in Ann Arbor, still must use the iron lung at night, but can sit in a wheel chair without a chest respirator during the day. She can now walk without mechanical breathing aid for approximately four hours a day.

STALEMATE BROKEN
The stalemate in the Legislature over emergency care for retarded children has been ended with what I feel is a responsible if not entirely satisfactory compromise. When a problem is settled by a compromise, nobody ought to be a victor. But the fact remains that the bipartisan bloc of legislators is now in a position to pass a bill for each teacher of our emergency program work. The compromise bill finally adopted provides for placing up to 120 of the children now on the waiting list in the Farmington institution on a constructive basis. SHOULD HAVE BOUGHT... It would have been better had we waited or bought the center in the Oakland County. At least we will now get a substantial number of beds at Farmington which can be occupied immediately and which are in the southeastern part of the state where the need is greatest. It was for this objective—not just the purchase of some real estate—that the bipartisan House coalition was fighting.
The House Democrats and "Young Turk" Republicans who are firmly and immediately called for the families of retarded children, deserve the thanks of the public. If they had not stood up under all kinds of political pressures, we would have had no southeastern Michigan (where most of the need is) beds on this emergency program, and we would have little in the way of immediate relief to other less fortunate families.
The Superintendent of Public Instruction, at my request, will report to me periodically on the way in which school boards have done. The alternative was to get the Legislature to pass a bill for each teacher of our emergency program work. The compromise bill finally adopted provides for placing up to 120 of the children now on the waiting list in the Farmington institution on a constructive basis. SHOULD HAVE BOUGHT... It would have been better had we waited or bought the center in the Oakland County. 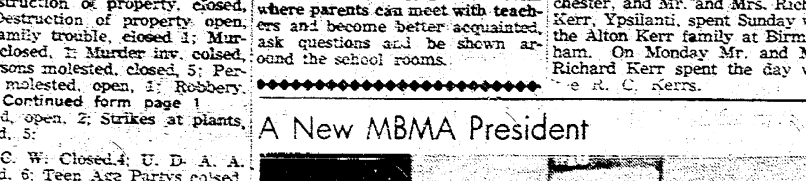
