Civil Defense Poll To Be Taken

A University of Michigan public opinion poll will soon determine whether or not American men and women should take on a "Civil Defense" training.

Reason for asking the question is that the Federal Civil Defense Administration is thinking about a referendum to decide whether Americans should take on a "Civil Defense obligation" as they do in Denmark, Sweden and Norway.

Mrs. Katherine Howard, a special advisor to the Civil Defense Administration, Val Peterson, said she suggested the public opinion poll after a recent trip to the three countries.

She said that in Sweden one out of every eight persons has already been trained in Civil Defense work. She said they voted themselves into what they call their "Civil Defense obligation" with each man and woman devoting 60 hours a year to Civil Defense training.

Mrs. Howard said she does not know when the next poll will be conducted but that usually about two are carried out each year to check on progress the agency is making in its public information program.

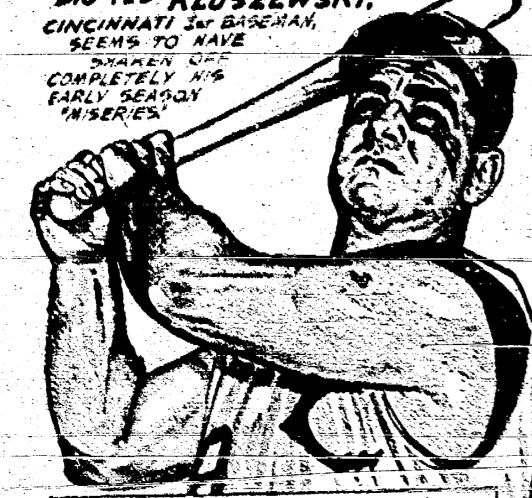
