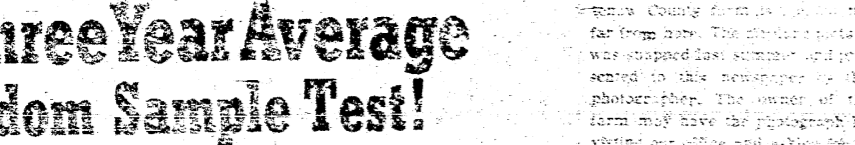

Two mornings later there was only one rocking horse under Christmas trees and only one Teddy bear in one small room. Only one pull-out bed had been left for Santa Claus. Only one small boy had waited for Santa's visit, and listened while we told him the story of Christmas.

We tried to make it a Merry Christmas for Almost Six, but he who took most of the hurt out of the experience for us, lay on his back, down in front of him and cried, "But Bobby is so little, and he'll never be so much."

Almost Six knew the answer. He looked at us amazed that the people could be so very, very stupid. But he won't really tell us much. Don't you remember? he said, "Grandma said that there isn't any night in Heaven, ever, and he'll think, when we get there, that we came the same way he did. He can't miss the night, not for just part of a day."

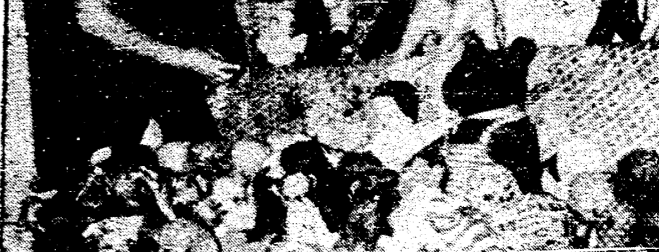
### Truck-Car Collision Kills Two Detroiters
