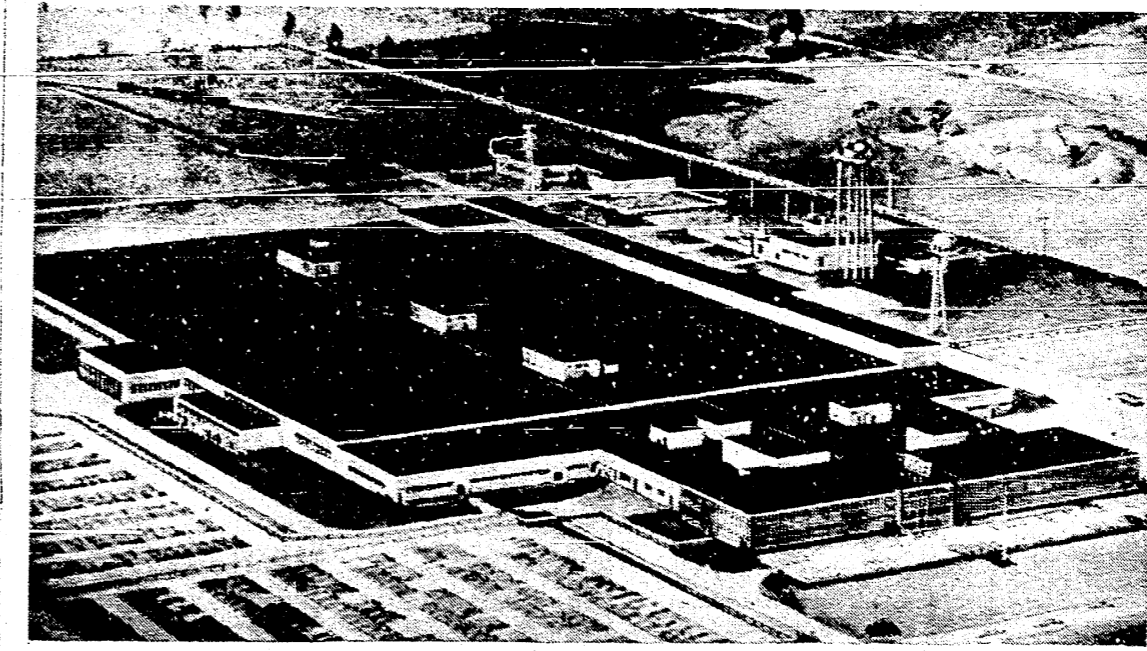
Students Visit Planetarium In Ann Arbor

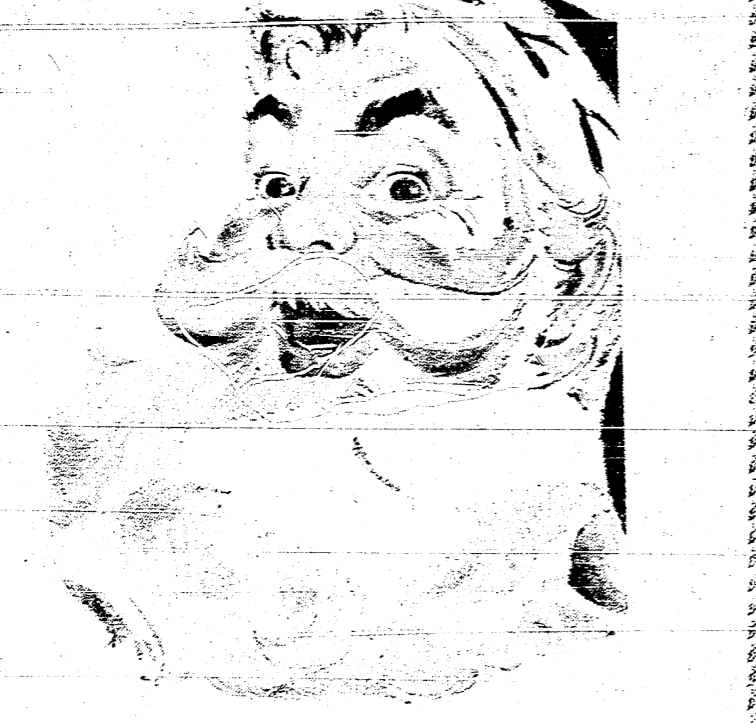
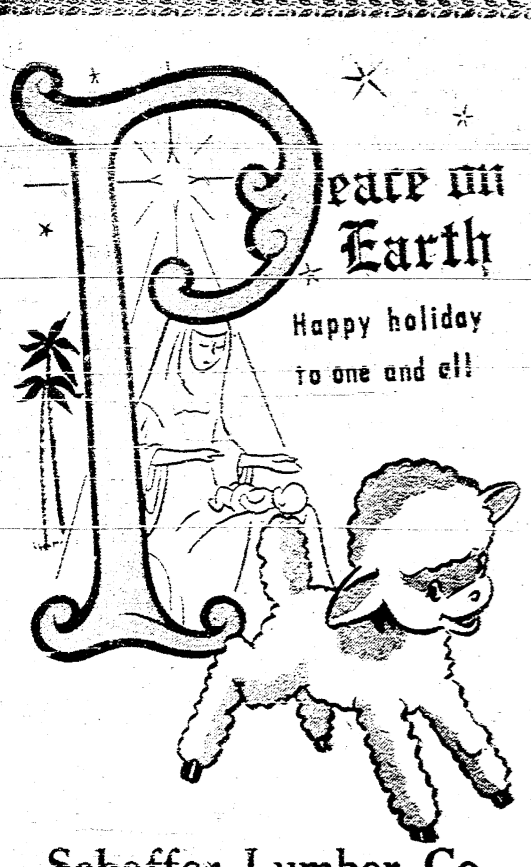
