

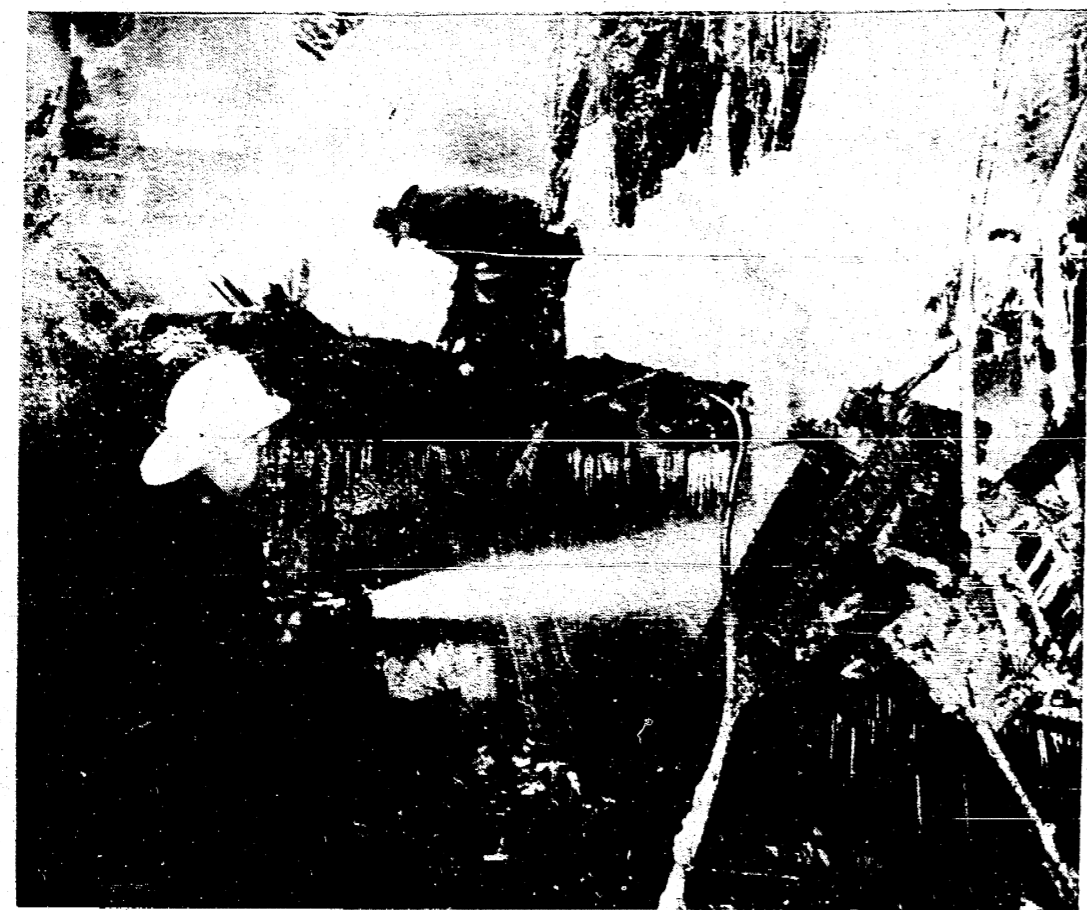
Extension Meet Well Attended By Manchesterites

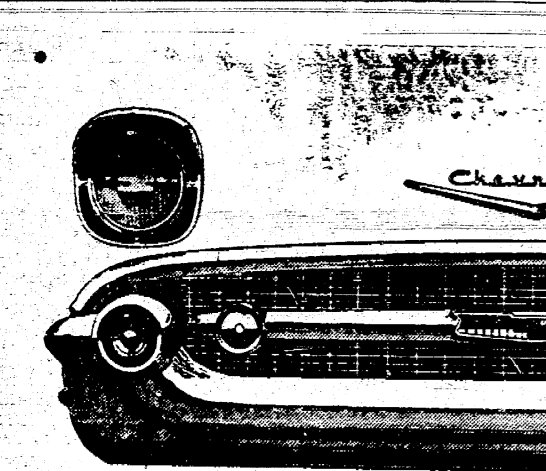

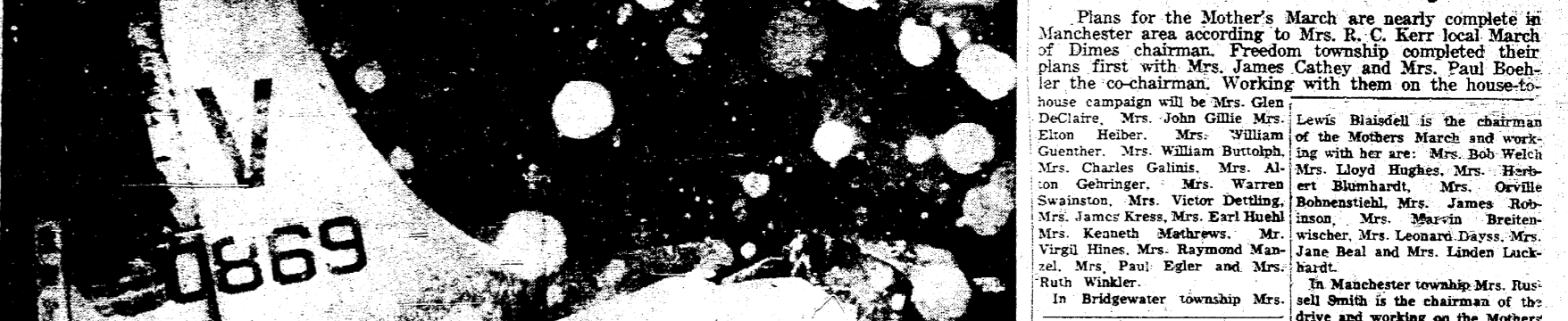
