## U. S. Farm Exports Expected to Reach New High in 1957

The agriculture department expects U. S. farm exports to move to a "high level" during the first half of 1957, it said more than three million bales of cotton may move during the three-month period.

Vegetable oil and oil seed sales are expected to show a sharp increase over 1956. Fruit and vegetable exports likewise have topped the previous peak set in 1954.

The department said some points in agricultural exports stemmed from propitious conditions abroad. It added that another contributing factor is the U. S. export program, which helped overcome problems of pricing and shipping shortages.

However, U. S. farm exports during the first half of this year "are not likely to equal the top billion dollar mark achieved during the last half of 1956," said the department.

For one thing, it pointed out, the U. S. crisis has adversely affected some farm commodities, and their large requirements for U. S. fuel and other non-agricultural commodities may cause them to reduce purchases of less essential farm commodities. Furthermore, added the department, farm exports are seasonally lower during the winter.

U. S. farm exports in 1956 topped the previous high achieved in 1955 and totaled four billion, 200 million dollars. Compared with 1955, this was a 30 per cent increase. Of the major commodity groups, only tobacco showed a decline for 1956, a year of heavy foreign restrictions.

For several commodity groups, 1956 was described as a year of substantial increase in export volume. Cotton exports rose 55 per cent over the 1955 low with farmers' aid under the government's commodity price program.

Corn and feed exports were about 10 per cent above the previous high of 1951. The increase reflected heavy movement of feed
