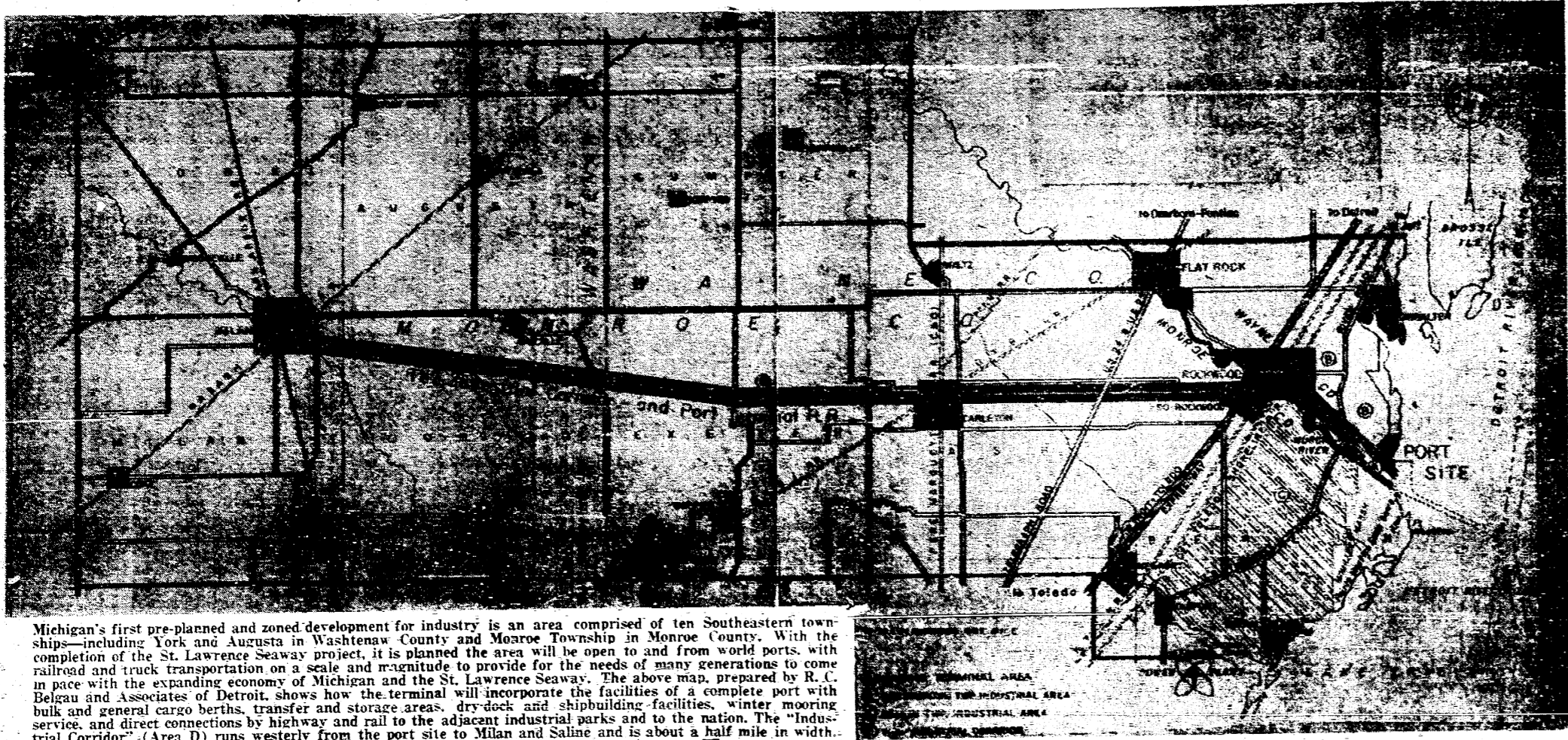


Saline, Milan, Seaway Development to Include Regional Terminal Drydock and An Industrial Park

THE SEAWAY AND OUR FUTURE

The direct relationship of the St. Lawrence Waterway and the future of Southern Washtenaw was outlined in this week in the proposed industrial corridor that will incorporate a large portion of Southern Washtenaw County.

An added stress on the importance of the St. Lawrence Waterway project is brought to our attention this week by Russell Blakelee of Detroit, a member of the international St. Lawrence Seaway who, while in Ann Arbor to attend a seminar at the University of Michigan, declared that the St. Lawrence Seaway will be the greatest thing for this area since the invention of the automobile.

He added that the effects of the Seaway will be felt down through the whole economy of the Great Lakes area, particularly in Southern Michigan. Benefits, he added, will be great, but they will spread slowly, making it impossible to assess their complete effect for some time to come.

"The unexpected effect of the Seaway is already evident," he said. "Shippers are becoming aware of benefits of low-cost water shipping and of savings due to mechanical handling of cargo." He went on to say that shipping freight from Detroit to the East Coast now costs \$14 a ton by rail, but only \$17.5 a ton by water. Once the Seaway is completed, water transportation should be even cheaper.

"Crash development" of harbors may be unwise, Blakelee declared. He urged cities to take "calm consideration" of natural obstacles, present ownership, and natural growth of trade in formulating harbor plans.

Forecasting specialization of ports - all ports, coal ports, transshipping ports - Blakelee said there will probably be few general cargo ports, and these will be limited to places with a variety of handling and storage facilities.

While all ports may benefit in varying degrees, Blakelee indicated, the ones now regarded as likely to benefit most are Detroit, Escanaba, and Muskegon, and Hamilton, Erie, and Sarnia, Ontario. He envisioned Toledo, Chicago, and Cleveland becoming specialized ports. Michigan, he pointed out, is already the biggest producer of exports, dollar-wise, of any state.

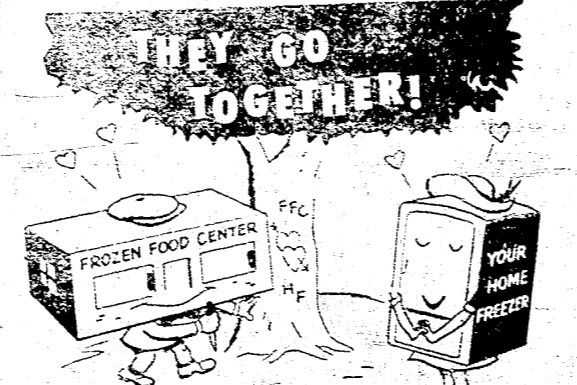

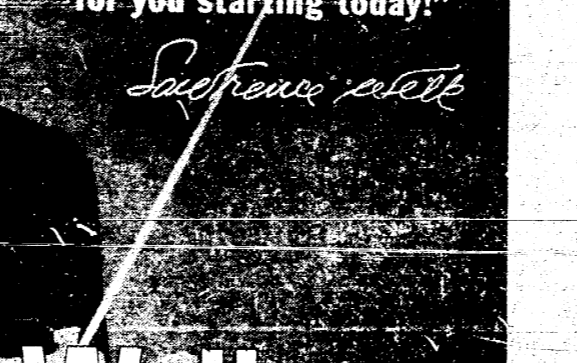

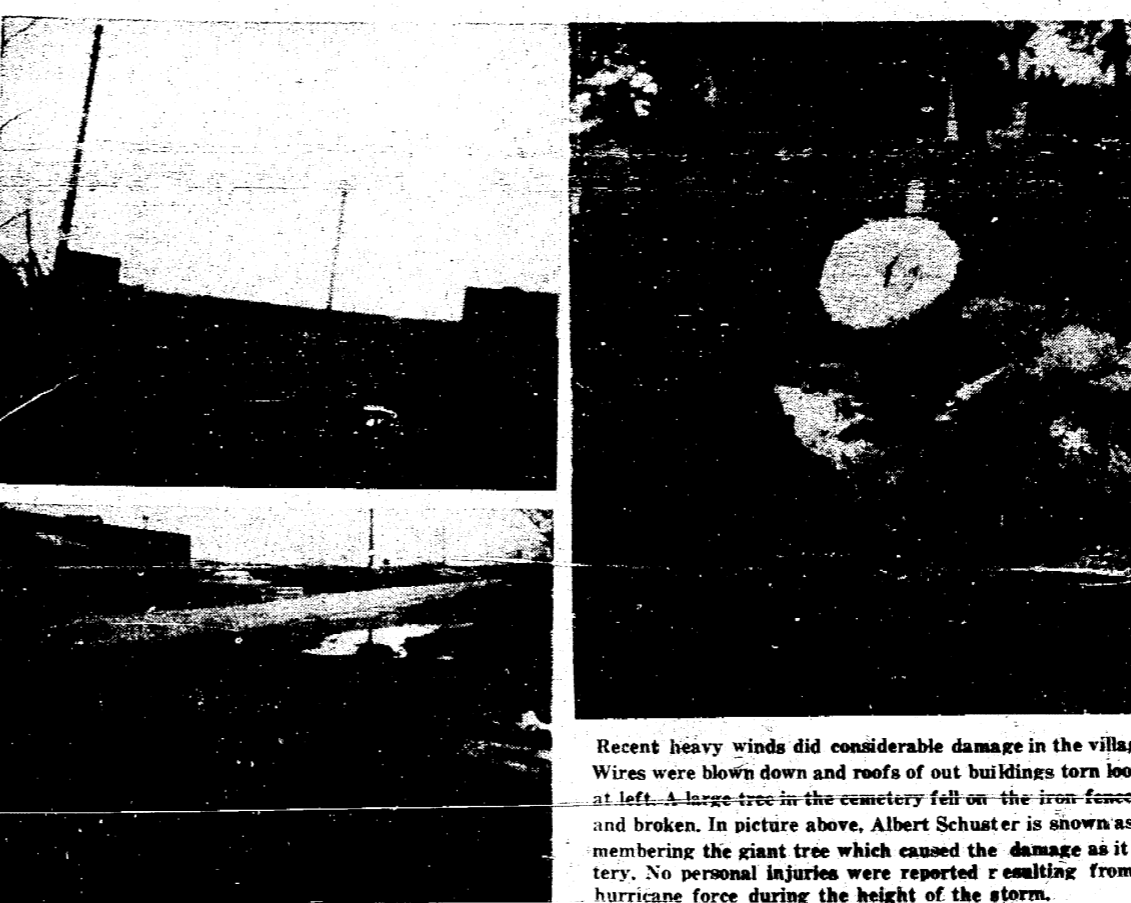
