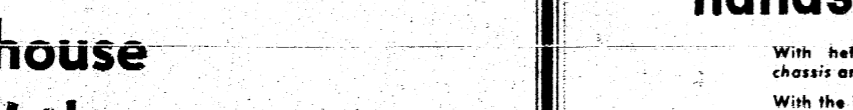

County's New Dog Detail Ready for Action May 31

The Washtenaw County Sheriff's Department has set up a new dog control system for Ann Arbor and most of Washtenaw County which will be in full operation May 31. The new detail is composed of City and county residents...

The two men will operate out of the sheriff's office at the County Jail from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday through Saturday each week. They will police every township, village and city in the county with the exception of East Lansing and Ypsilanti.

It is expected that the Sheriff's Department will make an arrangement with the Humane Society for impounding dogs picked up by the wardens. Any dog which is running loose is without vaccination license or is not under 'reasonable control' of its owner...
