



Townships' Tax Appeal To Be **Answered Soon**

The State Tax Commission will decide within 15 days whether to allocate three Washtenaw county twonships a small share of the available 15-mill property tax.

A hearing was held at the County Building on contentions of Manchester, Ypsilanti and Salem townships that they are entitled to at least 1 mill of taxing authority.

Tiney were denied miliage earlier this year by the County Tax Allocation Board. All other townships also received no millage.

Manchester seeks half a mill compared to Ypsilanti's asking for 1 mill and Salem from 1 to 3 mills.
