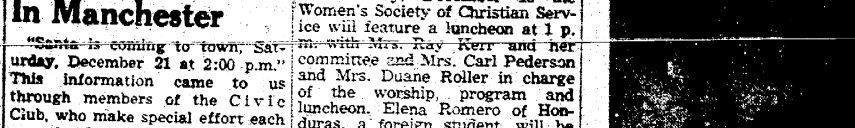
Robert Schebor, 25, is shown in a photograph taken during his graduation from the United States Army Weather School at Fort Belvoir, Illinois.



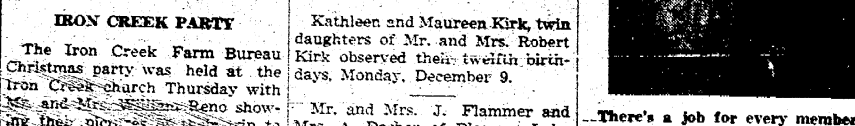

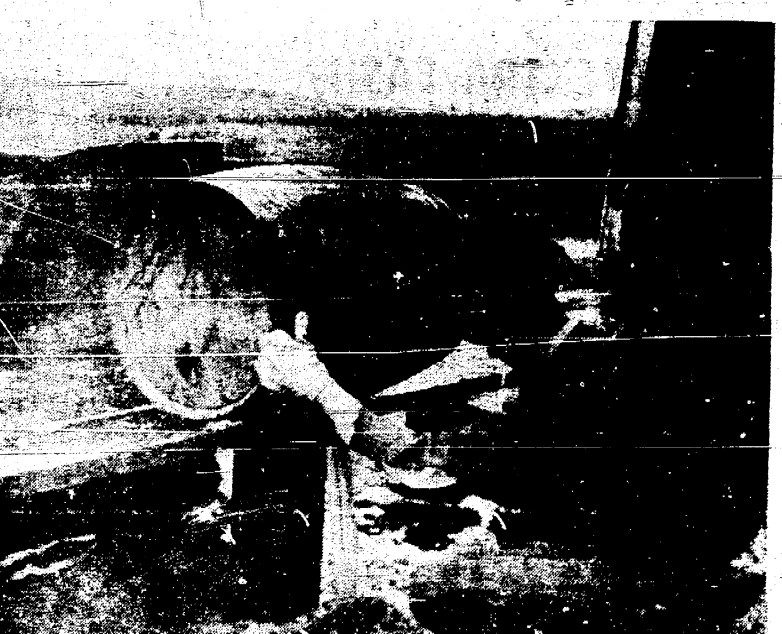

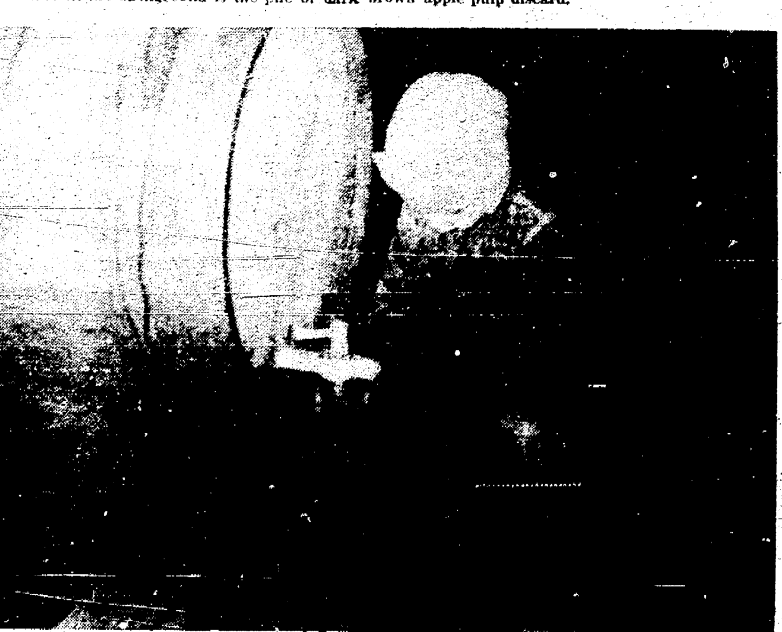

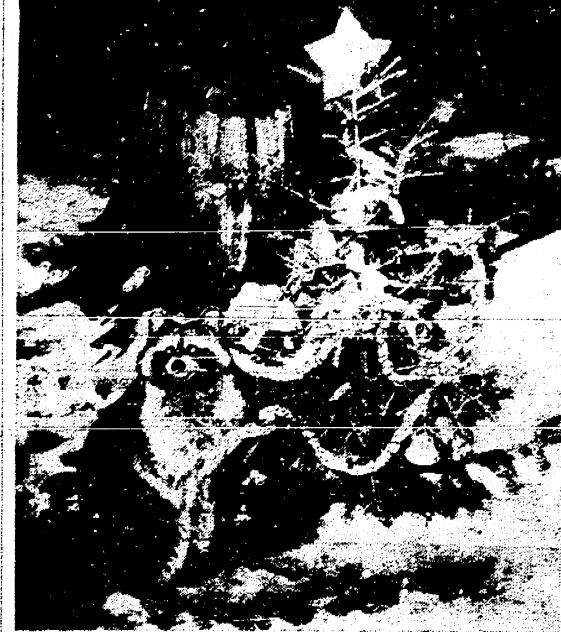
**Crash Program Gains Support**
