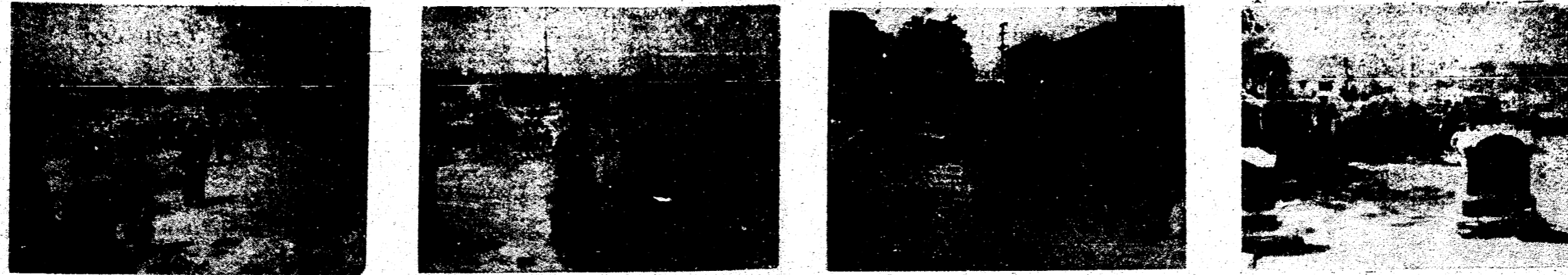

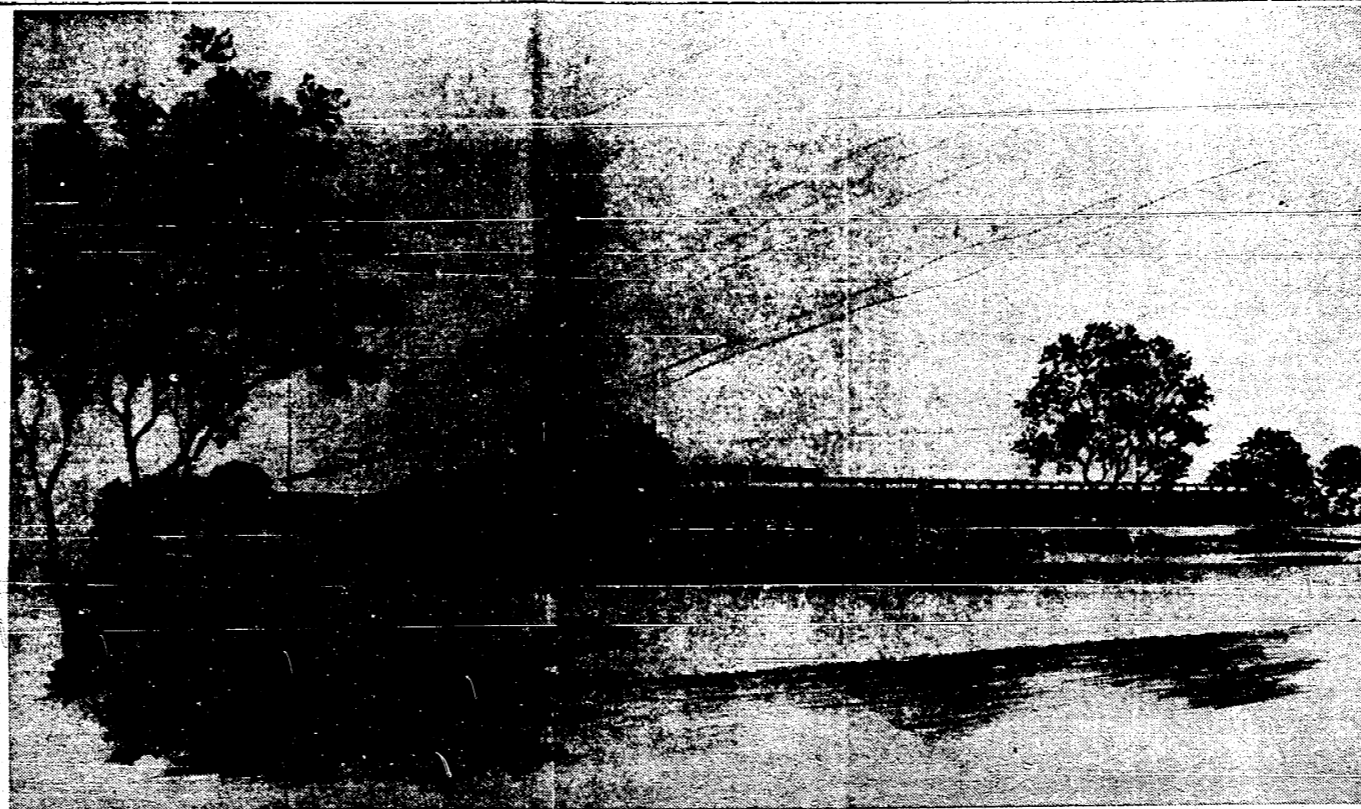

least six months, resident of the school district for at least 30 days, and own property assessed for taxes within the school district, or be the lawful husband, or wife of such a person. The school board asks only that voters acquaint themselves with the facts and then decide as an individual who to vote.

School Bond Issue

The Manchester school board has mailed out brochures giving the facts concerning the school problems of the Manchester school district.

Consensus figures show a minimum increase of enrollment of 250 children in the next five years. This increase will be seriously felt the next school year, officials point out. Classrooms will be overloaded even with the use of the two rural schools. One kindergarten section will be composed of about fifty anticipated enrollment of 108 kindergarten children as compared to 80 enrolled this year; and at least 100 kindergarten children per year for the next three years.

The Citizens Committee has recommended the building of elementary rooms within the village utility range, as this is the geographic area that needs housing for elementary students. The Board proposes to build these rooms as an addition to the Nellie Ackerson School for these reasons:

1. The school district owns the site and it is not put to any other use. This saves about \$30,000 in site purchase and development.
2. Water, sewers, sidewalks and roads are already serving this site.
3. Operation of this addition will save several thousands of dollars a year, as maintenance, administration, special education, and transportation will not be extended to a fourth location.
4. This establishes the Nellie Ackerson Elementary as a basic 13 room school. That is not only the most economical size to operate but will in the future permit housing of each grade through the sixth.

The remodeling program planned for the Intermediate school includes improving the lighting which gives one-fourth of the light recommended by health authorities. A small part of the funds in this proposal would be used to replace about 95 incandescent fixtures with fluorescent type. The heating is poor in the Intermediate school and provides no ventilation of class rooms, making a breeding ground for communicable diseases. Fourteen new unit ventilators in this building would be installed. There is a small amount of money budgeted for these reasons:

Maiden Flight Of DC8 Jetliner

"Far and away the finest first flight I ever made." That was how the pilot felt about the maiden flight of the Douglas DC8 Jetliner, capable of carrying 176 persons across the United States in 4 1/2 hours.

The four-engine DC8 flew 2 hours and 5 minutes Friday. It thundered off Municipal Airport at Long Beach, California, cruised over the ocean and landed at Edwards Air Force Base, California. After the flight, Pilot A. C. Heimendinger, 45, said: "Of all the Douglas transports I have flown, the DC8 is the greatest. The plane handled so well we were able to accomplish much more than we had originally programmed."

Heimendinger, a native of Manchester, is the son of Mrs. Charles Heimendinger of 215 S. Washington Street, Manchester. He formerly lived in Ypsilanti. He was graduated from Roosevelt High School and Eastern Michigan College in Ypsilanti and worked for

the Detroit Edison Company there for several years. He now lives in Santa Monica, California with his wife the former Allen Egger of Ypsilanti.

Douglas plans to start delivering the jetliners to airlines the middle of next year. It has 700 million dollars worth of orders from 17 airlines for 138 DC8's.

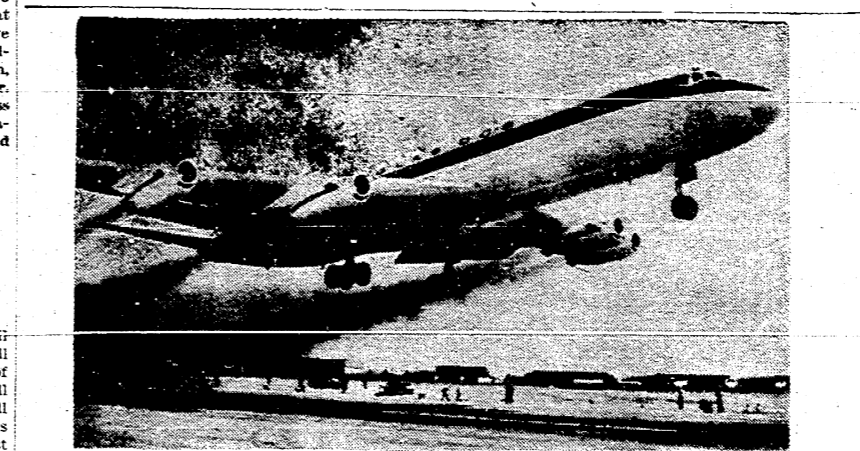
