## RECREATION PROGRNM GIS UNDRWAY JUNE 2OTH



The Manchester Board of Education is respect fully requesting that all qualified voters in the school district SUPPORT the board's request for extra operational millage on June 13,1966 . The board has given long and coreful consideration to the 1966-67 school budget and this millage is ABSOLUTELY NECESSARY IF THE SCHOOL DISTRICT IS TO OPERATE WITHOUT DEFICIT SPENDING.
The Boord's request for five mills of extra perational monies (TWO MILLS MORE THAN LAS Yar) was necessary because of an increase in the teacher s salary schedule. Increases given the most part, account for the two extro milis the boord is requesting. The bolance will be used for solary increases for custodians, bus drivers, cletical workers and instructional supplies.
THE TOTAL SCHOOL MILLAGE IS UP ONLY 2.6 MILLS OVER LAST YEAR. This slight increase covers BOTH the new high school debt levy and the increased operational millage. The present 1954 high school levy is down this year from 2.75 FORE THE OVERALL INCREASE IS JUST 2.6 MILLS OVER THE 1965-66 LEVY.
