Anticipating the coming glass collection this Saturday, and the coming school year that we hope will build our manpower, the Ecology Club has some ideas that we want to tell you about.

Our whole plans and projects have been based basically on what the Ann Arbor Ecology program has been doing. Now, with the Ann Arbor program espanded to tin can and newspaper recycling, we would like to undertake this too, but it will be hard unless we we can tone down our glass facet,

To begin with, glass has been recycled because so few pop and beer bottles are returnable, thus the consumer is responsible for the disposal of this glass. Especially in our cities, we are running out of available landfill. The real solution to this problem is to have all our pop and beer bottles returnable. The glass recycling center in Livonia has closed completely to devote their energies toward passing legislation against non-returnable bottles. A letter to our legislators would help them and us, because by recycling glass we are endorsing those industries that don't wish to make returnable bottles. Can and newspaper recycling is much more important because they can't be returned directly for reuse.

Recognizing this, we need to act accordingly. But until all pop and beer bottles become returnable, we will continue to have glass collections. The next one is this coming Saturday, August 28. Please no calls after 12:00 on Saturday at 428-9421.
