The tax rates for village property on this year's tax roll will drop this year
The tax levy for general operations, highways, parks, and water has been reduced from 14.31 mills to 12.7859 mills.

The tax levy for debt service on bonds, approved by the voters for the new wastewater treatment plant and for sewer projects, has been reduced from 5.33 mills to 4.6 mills.
