



Industrial Maps of Rocky Mountain States

Each year finds the industrial maps growing more popular as the natural resources of the Rocky Mountain states become better appreciated.

General Features. Wagon roads, railroads, cities, towns and country postoffices, township lines, drainage, rivers, lakes, mountain ranges and mountain peaks.

Mineral Areas. The mineral areas in each state are shown in a distinctive color with special designations to show the location of the various precious and semi-precious metals, also indicating which are produced in each mining camp.

Coal Fields. The coal areas are carefully charted showing the general distribution of coal deposits and the location of the principal outcroppings.

Agricultural and Irrigated Areas are shown in distinctive colors giving all the principal irrigation projects under construction and showing, to a large extent, the areas available for cultivation.
