


SITE DESCRIPTION


Located on the corner of Weston and Division, the McMullen Building occupies a lot approximately 90 x 135 feet. The site is bound on the west by Division Avenue and south by Weston Avenue. The closest street to the east is Commerce Avenue and to the north is Fulton. The property has parking spaces immediately to the rear of the building. A parking structure is also available at the corner of Fulton and Division Avenue, a short block away. Currently, all city utilities are available to the site.
