gearbox. Final drive is by roller chain from the gearbox to the three section roller, with differential.

Maximum speeds are 2.4 mph in 1st gear, 3.6 mph in 2nd gear and 5.3 mph in 3rd gear. Maximum reverse speed is 3.6 mph.

Price of the roller drive Condor with cylinder unit and grass box is £370— with the rotary mower version at £329. A roller seat is available at £29.
