

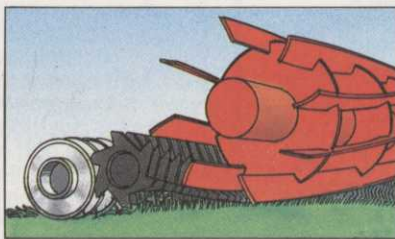

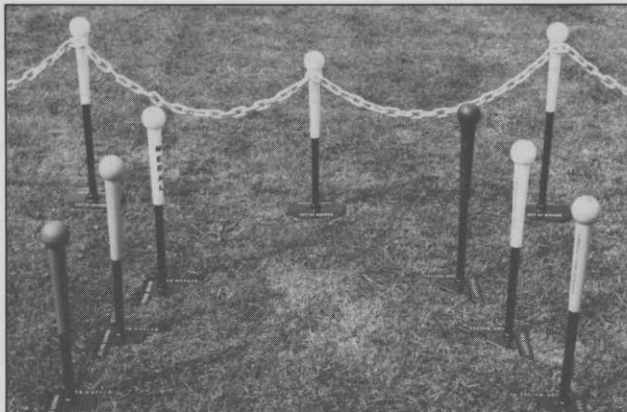
tunity to meet socially with their families. I sincerely hope we have a large turn-out for this function.
