# David celebrates Silver anniversary




David Rea, Head Greenkeeper at Droitwich GC, recently completed 25 years service at the club and was presented with a watch to mark the occasion.

Ireland's newest golf hole development, Ring of Kerry Golf and Country Club, opened during he week of The Open Championship and lays claim to the title of first quality upland course in the country.
