It gives visitors a genuine one stop shop for their clubhouse and golf course needs at a time of year which is ideal for visitors.



I am delighted that this exhibition will have the backing of both the Association of Golf Club Secretaries (AGCS) and the Association of Golf Course Owners and I look forward to welcoming many new companies and visitors to Harrogate.

We have monitored the progress of Clubhouse since its early days based at the National Agricultural Centre in Stoneleigh, through its move to the NEC in

Birmngham. We have always considered that the ideal location for this exhibition would be the Harrogate International Centre alongside BTME and we have worked hard to achieve this end.

No longer will golf clubs have to justify the expense of sending their personnel to shows at seperate locations on different dates. Now the focus of the industry and the game will be on one place at one time with the
