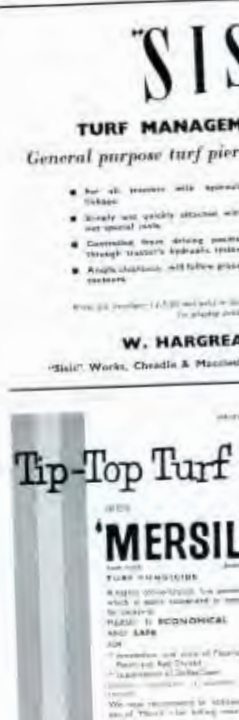


Back in time
