On the 15th September the rescheduled Cumbria Cup was played at Penrith. This time the weather was kind and we all had a good day. In September I was invited by the Swedish Golf Federation to join three Canadians and their own team of agronomists on a tour of Sweden, taking in seven golf courses, three of which we played. We also stayed over at Jonkoping for the trade show and seminars, which were excellent. Our tour started in Malmo and ended in Stockholm, stopping to visit or play golf courses on the way. One course we visited was the links course of Falsterbo, situated in a nature reserve at the tip of Sweden's south west peninsular where the waters of the Sound and the Baltic Sea meet. A bird watchers paradise which attracts thousands of migrating birds. The course was founded in 1909, consisting of 9 holes later extended to 18 in 1930. Walking around the links I was told that my old friend Jim Arthur had been their advisor for many years and they still have fond memories of his visits. One very interesting fact is that while the course was built against the sea and ran alongside the coast line, so much sand has been washed ashore they are now looking to construct a third nine holes where the sea used to be. I would like to thank Maria Strandberg, who organised the whole trip and escorted us around, and the Swedish Golf Federation for their generosity. on the golf course.


