## PRACTICAL RESEARCH (Question Box)

- Q. How long should we wait after applying 24D before we can seed?
- As At least three to four weeks.
- Q. What is the best way to cradicate knot weed from fairways without interfering with play by leaving infested areas bare?
- A. Sow grass seed in late summer or early Fall, and treat any seedling knot-wood in the Spring with two 2,4D applications around April 15th and May 15th.
- Q. when would you spray for dandellons, and other weeds during the full period.
- A. Any time where blue-grass is concerned BUT Fall. 2,4D treatment on bent turf is dangerous.
- Q. Mat. Storicl grass from permanent turi?
- A. New chemicals are under abservation at present and are nothing much from a last around of lead in applied works to the Spring has proved quit more at a rate of five pounds per thousand aquare feet.
