### LIFE SAVING HINTS FOR THUNDERSTORMS

- 1) Stay indoors during a thunderstorm if you can.
- 2) Seek shelter in buildings. Do not stand under trees unless surrounded by them. Avoid the tall trees. A grove is much safer than a single tree.
- 3) Stop tractor work and get off, especially if the tractor is pulling metal equipment. Tractors and other farm implements are often struck by lightning, especially if they are grounded.
- 4) Avoid wire fences, hilltops, small exposed sheds, and wide open places. Don't work on fences, pipelines, or structural steel fabrication during an electrical storm.
- 5) Stay out of water and small boats.
- 6) Don't use metal objects such as fishing poles and golf clubs. Golfers wearing cleated shoes are particularly good lightning rods.
- 7) Stay away from open doors and windows, fireplaces, radiators, stoves, metal pipes, sinks and plug-in electrical appliances. Don't use such things as electric hair dryers, electric tooth brushes, or electric razors during a bad storm.
- 8) Don't use the telephone during a thunderstorm unless you must — lightning may strike telephone lines outside.
- 9) Don't take laundry off the clothesline, and don't handle flammable materials in open containers. Don't take a bath or shower during the storm.
- 10) Stay in your car or pickup if traveling. Metal-topped autos offer excellent protection. However, convertibles do not offer this safety.
- 11) If your conduct hasn't been good lately — PRAY!
