“MY LITTLE BABIES ARE DYING”

It's discouraging to have flower and vegetable seeds die after you have spent the money and time to plant them. To help avoid this, follow these practices:

- 1) buy fresh healthy seeds
- 2) buy seeds adapted to Northern Illinois
- 3) do not over water
- 4) do not over plant - excessive crowding increases disease problems
- 5) do not plant too deeply (follow package directions)
- 6) give bright light but not direct sun
- 7) keep moist but not wet.

Easter lilies can be sometimes forced to rebloom once in the garden. However, they usually die out during the winter following their placement in the garden.

To hold in flower as long as possible ... keep it cool, moist but not wet and in bright light but not direct sun.
