Annual bluegrass	1/8" - 1 1/2"
Perennial ryegrass	3/4" - 2"
Kentucky bluegrass	1" - 2"
Chewings fescue	3/4" - 2"
Hard fescue	1" - 2"
Spreading fescue (Red)	1 1/2" - 2 plus"
Tall fescue	1" - 2 plus"
