The salary increases ranged from a 4% to 15% with the average salary increase to be 8.2%. The 1986 operating budget ranged from \$280,000 to \$358,000 with the average budget being \$325,300. The Capitol budget ranged from \$25,000 to \$56,000 and the average was \$44,800.
