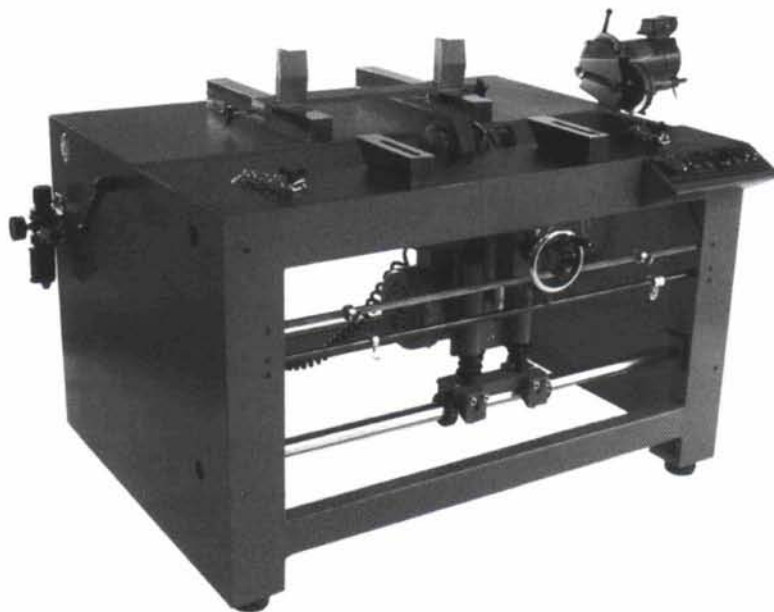
Doug Long has left Streamwood Oaks to become the Vice President of Operations for the Central Division of Crown Golf Properties. His responsibilities will encompass providing assis-
