organic fertilizers and disease, combining DMSO with fungicides, "does sweetening your turf make it fat for disease?", grasses as biofuels, sudden oak death, impatiens breeding at UIUC, USDA/NC7 woody plant evaluations, effects of planting and mulching depths on white and green ashes, emerald ash borer, and bedding plant selections. Thanks to everyone at the U of I for their hard work and important research.

Not that nutsedge is a huge problem in these parts, but Gowan, Inc. just came out with a new selective herbicide for the control of it called "SedgeHammer." Why is this newsworthy? I just think the name is awesome.
