

## "Stewardship is Everyone's Concern"

What is stewardship? Stewardship is the attendance to or the administration of certain products or services in a responsible manner. In what area is stewardship especially important? It is very important with the use of pesticides that are applied to a golf course area.

When one speaks about responsible use, the first thing that comes to mind is the proper attention to the **entire** label applied by a particular manufacturer. It is imperative that we, as applicators, are aware of the full extent of the label and follow it to its entirety.

Secondly, stewardship means that when a material is applied, it is applied in the manner consistent with the label. Many times problems that occur with litigation or other concerns come from "off label" uses of the chemical.

Knowing how products work is extremely important also. You should educate yourself to the fullest extent when using particular products. This is where the distributor representative or manufacturer representative can be of great assistance. They are not there only to sell you products, but they are available to educate you on the best application methods and on other label needs. If they do not have the answer to a particular question, they should have the resources to obtain those answers.

As you can see stewardship involves all individuals who are involved throughout the process, from manufacturing to final spray use. The responsible use of any product, not only with pesticides, is critical. It will assure that many of the good products now available will remain available.



### "Update on CGCMA Education Program"

The final part of the CGCMA's winter educational program was completed on February 13, 1990 at the Lake Zurich Echo plant.

The topic was, "Understanding the Quirks of Two Cycle Engines and Trouble Shooting in the Correct Sequence". The speaker was Echo's National Senior Service Manager, Andy Kuczman. Andy has 17 years experience working with two cycle engines. Three types of aspiration on two cycles were discussed.

The types are reed valve, piston ported, and ventilated piston. The subject of the compression of primary and secondary crank case and cylinder operation was addressed. Carburation, exhaust, and ignition were also important issues that were covered.

The last item on the agenda was how to correctly make carburation adjustments. Many useful pieces of information and ideas were conveyed during the meeting. Because of the hands on nature of the seminar, much knowledge was gained by all that attended.

Hopefully, in the future we may have the opportunity to hear Andy speak again about problems and advancements on two cycle engines.

## Shellcrackers Keep the Geese Away

Once again the topic of geese came up at the March MAGCS meeting. Like many courses, I had my fair share of them. My biggest problem with the geese was the droppings they left behind.

I had heard that Dave Beno at Bonnie Brook and Paul Bastron at Glen Flora were successfully scaring their geese away with the help of shellcrackers. I decided to give it a try.

Shellcrackers are a class "C" explosive that sounds like a gunshot when they explode. They are considered somewhat like fireworks, therefore I needed written permission from the village of Northbrook and the police department before I could legally purchase them.

I ordered 600 shellcrackers and purchased a 12 gauge flare gun. The flare gun needed to be reamed out slightly to hold the shellcrackers.

Before I could begin firing shellcrackers, the Northbrook police asked that I notify all neighbors that bordered Sportsman's. I drafted a letter explaining our intentions, and had two of my employees distribute copies to each house.

Finally, it was time to begin. We began firing shellcrackers last October. At that time we had over 500 geese.

The first week my staff and I fired nearly 500 shellcrackers. Within this one week period we had completely rid Sportsman's of geese.

Now, whenever any geese land on the golf course, a single shot clears the course again. The geese are so spooked that, quite often, they fly away before I can get a shot off.

It took a lot of time and effort to get this program implemented, but it's a solution that works.
