## Hassenplug designing four layouts

The Pittsburgh, Pa.-based architectural firm of Hassenplug Associates, Inc. is currently involved with four new planning-stage projects.

Erie Island Resort & Marina is an 18-hole private club located in Port Clinton, Ohio.

Another private facility, 18-hole layout is being designed for Groff's Farm Restaurant & Golf Club in Mount Joy, Pa.

A third private club, Seven Oaks Country Club in Beaver, Pa., is adding an additional nine holes.

Waltz Farms, Inc. in Limerick, Pa. is a daily fee, 18-hole course.

## Golfplan working on overseas plans

The Golfplan-Ronald Fream Design Group is involved with several overseas courses.

Near Bangkok, Thailand, the Santa Rosa, Calif.-based firm is designing 45 holes for the owners of the Panya Resort Development. The first course is a 27-hole championship layout being built over a rice paddy near Bangkok International Airport. The second, located 50 miles south of Bangkok,

### Richard retained for Mass. course

Richard and Associates of Sagamore Beach, Mass., will design and construct a championship, 18-hole course in Hanson, Mass.

The private, par 72 course will weave through working cranberry bogs for 6,800 yards. It will resemble the inland, parkland courses of Great Britain that feature natural mounding and fairways framed by large-scale trees.

Richard and Associates principal Ray Richard said of the new project: "In view of the native vegetation, soil, type and proximity to the working cranberry bogs, we can construct a fine golf course on this location.

"In addition, the existing grades shall provide a pleasing amount of character and shotmaking value, without a large amount of earthmoving. A golf course in New England must not look contrived."

### Schmidt focusing on shot value

Landmark Club Management has signed an agreement with Davidson Communities of San Diego, Calif., to design and build an 18-hole public golf facility in Ramona, Calif.

Vice President of Landmark Golf Course Design Lee Schmidt, who worked for Pete Dye before joining Landmark in 1979, will oversee the project

"There will be an emphasis on shot values and strategy for all levels of play," said Schmidt of the new facility. "We stress mental play in designing golf holes — that is, we make distinctive holes that golfers will enjoy and remember."

This is the third Landmark Signature Course.

is an 18-hole championship facility over rolling hillsides with mountain and sea vistas. Both projects will open for play in mid-1991.

Design studies for an 18-hole, exclusive country club along the lush green Cote Basque near the resort city of Biarritz in southwestern France are nearing completion. Golf d'Arcangues is situated on the estate of the Marquis d'Arcangues, whose family title to the property dates back to 1151. The course will be playable the middle of next year.

Construction site clearing gets underway this spring at the Pirita Golf project in Tallinn, the capital of the Baltic republic of Estonia, U.S.S.R. The future site of the Soviet National Golf Teaching Center, the facility includes an 18-hole championship course, a

nine-hole teaching course and a huge practice range along the Pirita River.

Golfplan is also busy along the North African coast where it is designing the 27-hole Dunes de Morjane at Tabarka, Tunisia. The seaside site resembles Pebble Beach and Cypress Point in California with its sand dunes, seaside cliffs, pine and oak trees and moderate to cool temperatures. It will be playable in the spring of 1991.

Finally there is the Tullybannocher Golf Course at Comrie in the Highlands of Scotland, just a few miles from the world famous Gleneagles Resort. The 18-hole, daily fee course is being designed as a true Scottish Highland course set in a mountainous glen with vistas of rock cliffs, lakes and ancient stone farm houses.



Euclid's axiom about the shortest distance between two points is ignored when cart paths are placed well into the rough. The reason for this is that golf balls take lively, erratic bounces off of concrete or asphalt paths and their presence in the fairway would alter the game.
