## Clark heads new slate of officers for ASGCA

Tom Clark, a partner in the firm of Ault, Clark & Associates, Ltd. in Kensington, Md., was elected president of the American Society of Golf Course Architects at the group's 45th annual meeting in England.

Other officers elected were Vice President Arthur Hills of Arthur Hills & Associates in Toledo, Ohio; Secretary Gerald Matthews of Matthews & Associates in Lansing, Mich; and Treasurer Donald Knott of Robert Trent Jones II International in Palo Alto, Calif.

Bob Moote of Brampton, Ontario, Canada, was elected to the board of governors. Clark has been involved in feasibility, design and construction of more than 500 golf course projects over the past 20 years. His designs include Tournament Players Club-Avenel in Potomac, Md.; Emerald River Country Club in Laughlin, Nev.; The Landings in Warner Robins, Ga.; and The Highlands in Bella Vista, Ark. His latest course, Kiln Creek Country Club, opened June 1 in Newport News, Va.

A 1971 graduate of Penn State University

with a bachelor's degree in landscape architecture, Clark joined Edmund B. Ault, Ltd. that same year. He became a full partner with Edmund and Brian Ault in 1984.

Hills earned a bachelor's degree in agronomy from Michigan State University and a master's degree in landscape architecture at the University of Michigan. He worked for a Los Angeles landscape design firm for a short time before entering private practice as a golf course architect in 1967, based in Toledo, Ohio.

Matthews' family is the first to have three generations accepted as members of the ASGCA. His father, W. Bruce Matthews, is a fellow of the society.

In 1959 Bruce and son Jerry formed Matthews & Associates. Grandson and nephew W. Bruce Matthews III later joined the firm.

Jerry earned a bachelor's degree in landscape architecture and bachelor's and master's degrees in urban planning from Michigan State University.

Knott has worked with Jones since 1977. He received a bachelor's degree in landscape architecture in 1969 and a master of architecture degree in 1973 from the University of California at Berkeley, and immediately joined Robert Trent Jones Inc. Afterthreeyearsworking abroad with Trent Jones Sr., Knott returned to the United States and rejoined Jones Jr.
