New Fungicide Tests Show Control Without Injury

Puraturf, trade name of the organic mercury fungicide that first was known to greenkeepers by promising results produced in dollar spot and brown patch experiments at Rhode Island Agricultural Experiment station in 1943 and 1944, now is being distributed for its makers, Gallowhur Chemical Co., by Niagara Sprayer & Chemical Co., Middleport, N. Y. The fungicide, which was identified as Puratized N5D in the earlier Rhode Island tests, was subjected to extensive tests at 30 clubs in various parts of the U. S. during 1945. Results of the tests are reported as highly satisfactory. Puraturf showed excellent control of dollar spot, brownpatch and copper spot, without causing injury to turf. Recommended rate of application is 1/2 pint Puraturf with 50 gals, water, applied to 5,000 to 6,000 sq. ft. of turf. Application is by spray. The product mixes readily with water and does not have to be stirred constantly to be kept in solution. Preventive program recommended is spraying every 7 to 10 days, depending on rainfall and degree of infestation; beginning before the disease appears and continuing through the season.
