Ridgemoor CC (Chicago District) hon-ored Howard R. Davis, its pro for 25 years at a Silver Anniversary party which was featured by a Saturday afternoon golf tournament and at an evening dinner which was the best attended affair of the club's many banquets. Davis was presented with a new automobile as evidence of the members' gratitude for the faithful, competent and cheerful service he's given to them and their guests. Howard came into golf in 1907 as a caddy at the old Calumet CC, 95th and Cottage Grove Ave. Chicago. In 1914 Howard and some of his pals walked from Calumet to Midlothian to follow Walter Hagen in the Hague's first national triumph. It was a round-trip jaunt of about 35 miles.

Howard has developed many fine pro and amateur golfers. Despite having had for years one of the most crowded lesson calendars of any pro in the country,. Davis, in the few rounds of golf he does get to play, still bats around in the low 70s. Of his 5 children 3 sons recently have been in war service. Some years ago Davis was quite a track athlete in the Chicago district, especially in sprints. He still keeps in training and neither drinks nor smokes.
