We started on an Aqua-GRO program in 1959. Each year the greens get better and better. Aqua-GRO is not the whole answer but it's at big help. All the localized dry spots are GONE. We always used to lose grass on 3 or $\overline{4 \text{ contoured greens}}$. Today, we hold the turf and syringe less. From 3 times a day syringing we now handle these problem greens the same as the rest of the course-a maximum of 2 or normal one syringing a day. We also can hold off the start of syringing from June 'til later in July. The Bermuda tees have denser cover and must be thinned out more often. I credit this better turf to the plant getting more efficient use out of the water and nutrients on an Aqua-GRO program.
