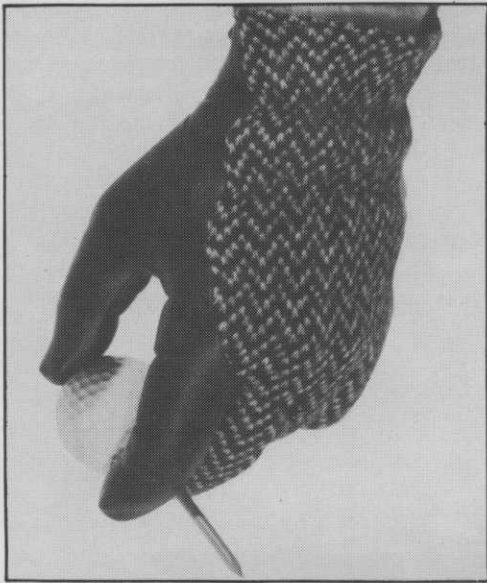
New light-duty tractor offers hydrostatic drive plus three speeds

Hydrostatic drive connected to a three-speed geared transmission gives Allis-Chalmers Corp.'s model 720 tractor unusual ability to match engine revolutions, horsepower needs, and ground speed to the particular job being performed. The system offers speed up to 10.4 miles per hour forward and 6.2 mph in reverse. One lever controls both speed and direction, without shifting or clutching. A two-cylinder four-cycle engine displacing 50 cubic inches puts out 19½ horsepower and plenty of torque to avoid stalling when under heavy load. Turning radius is 36 inches.
