## Nematicide injector

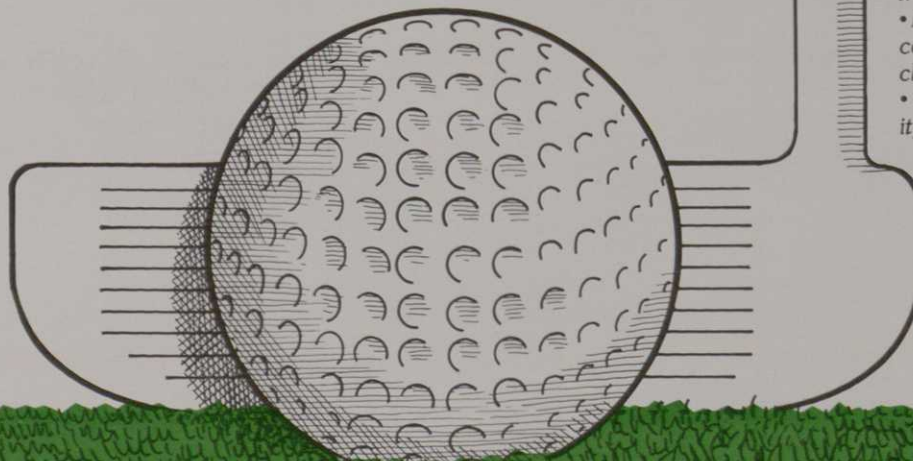
