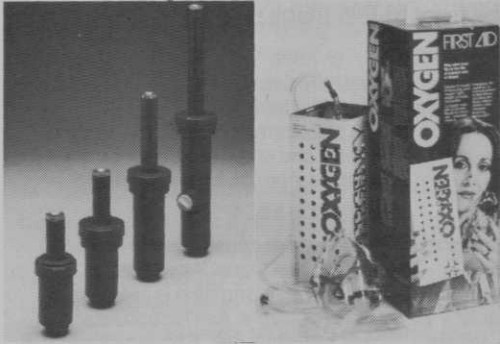


## Pop-up heads

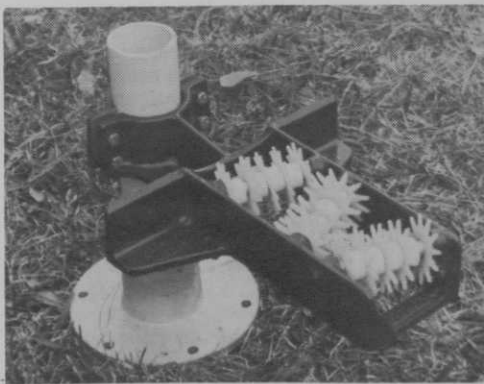

## Cleat cleaner

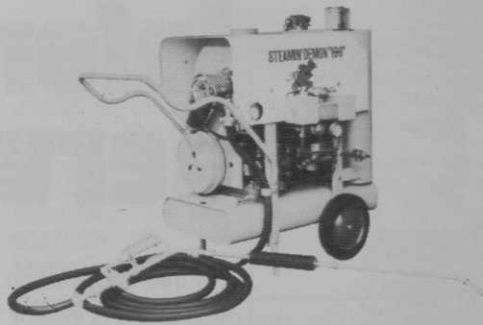

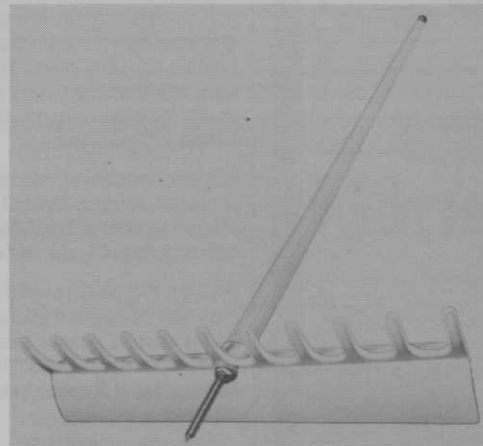
