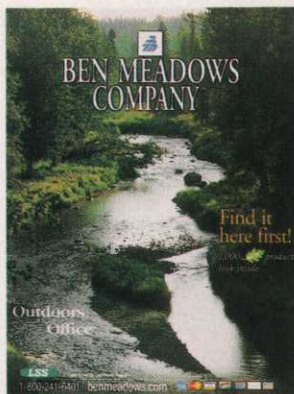
Full Coverage Irrigation has expanded its line of high uniformity nozzles to include two nozzle sets to retrofit the Toro
