#### DOUBLE-ROTARY'S NEW SPRINKLER

Kansas City, Mo.—The Double-Rotary Sprinkler Co, has recently placed on the market a companion model to the Double Rotary Sprinkler for golf courses, the Double Rotary Junior which is for home owners and club gardens.

This new Double Rotary has the features of the heavy duty model plus a stationary feature and a lower price. Th's means it is a rotary sprinkler, a stationary sprinkler and a stationary spray all in one. It produces a mist-like spray for seeded flower beds; rain-like drops for blooming flowers and tender lawns; or a drenching shower for shrubs and gardens.

This Junior model operates on the Double Rotary principle: pressure through the hose nozzle causes the aluminum wheel to rotate at high speed. This action through a simple system of self-oiling reducing gears, causes the entire sprinkler head to rotate on its standard. The water is cut into rain-like drops or a mist-spray



by the distributor wheel. An adjustable nozzle easily regulated by the fingers regulates the outcoming water for shower or spray.

"Three years of constant experimenting and laboratory research are behind the development of this new model sprinkler," says Lou E. Holland, president of the



Double Rotary Sprinkler's new "little brother."

Double Rotary Co. The Double Rotary Junior operates wherever water pressure is available and sprinkles over a circular area, when rotating, up to 80 feet in diameter (more than 5,000 square feet) or down to 15 feet in diameter, according to water pressure.

The Junior model is sold on a ten-day trial basis under money-back guarantee.

He related that the preparation had a 100 per cent record of curing the ailment, and finally decided to finance the manufacture of the material instead of giving away bottles of it to his friends and their friends.

## Hickory Shaft Conference at Columbus, O., June 4

A GENERAL conference on hickory golf shafts has been called by the U. S. government Bureau of Standards for June 14 at Columbus, O. All interested are invited to attend. Specifications and methods of testing will be presented for approval at this meeting. This data now is available in printed form at Department of Commerce offices.

Committees of the Hickory Golf Shaft Manufacturers' association and National Golf Club Manufacturers' association. working with the Bureau of Standards. have devised a practical mechanical method of testing hickory shafts that is said to provide assurance of uniformity in the supply of hickory shafts according to specifications. Leading manufacturers of hickory golf shafts have been working energetically for some time to get this matter of a scientific check on standardized quality to give them and their customers protection. They claim the problem now has been solved with complete satisfaction.
