

fect contact with the straight blade even if the latter is bent or sprung.

On most mowers it is not necessary to grind the straight blade or cutter bar, but when it is badly worn and "wavy" or uneven there is only one way to sharpen it—on a grinding wheel. For this purpose the Peerless Jr. is equipped with a heavy attachment bar which holds the straight



blade so that both the face and the edge can be ground quickly and accurately in one setting by rotating the bar.

A special 8-inch grinding wheel on the end of the main shaft is also furnished for grinding grass and hedge shears, sickles, scythes and other edge tools.




