Four standard locker louvers in each door allow ample space for the passage of air into the unit and, where the maximum amount of ventilation is needed and where contents must be available for inspection at all times, grilled steel doors are optional equipment. The bottom of each unit has been made flush with the door frame so the unit can be thoroughly cleaned.
