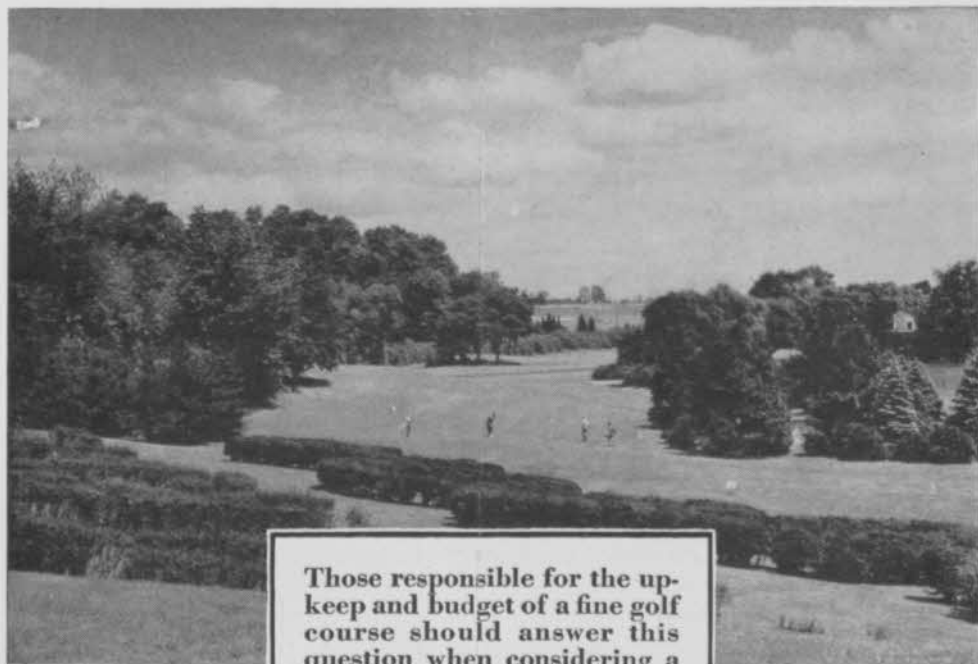


HERSHEY—another fine course piped with Cast Iron
