mouths water. It would give British golf a good "kick in the pants" and wake up those who now promote our tournaments if an American business man were to go to England and stage a first class tournament with prizes of the same magnitude that are given to American contestants over here. It should, incidentally, turn into an excellent gamble for the promoter himself. I know the entry would be enormous and the interest the general public would take equally big.

During the war, we had to make our clubs pay as best we could. Due to the fact that many of our members were abroad in war service, the financial income was, with few exceptions, very much smaller than in previous years. Means were tried to meet the money shortage and I do not know whether it has been this country's experience also, but the takings at the bar in nearly every case were practically quadrupled during the war years. It was this experience that made the golf club proprietors realize that there was a great deal of money to be made out of the social side of golf—much more in fact than from the ordinary revenue from the golf course itself. Because of this our clubs are

coming round to your way of doing business. Incidentally, an enormous amount of money was unexpectedly made by seaside courses selling their over-abundance of sand. This surprised them a great deal as I daresay it does you.

The GI Bill of Rights is indeed a remarkable one, for it seems to me to provide for practically every idea and wish that the young American may have. I was playing golf with a well known profes-sional the other day and he was telling me that he had had a request from an American boy now discharged to become a golf professional. He wished to serve under this famous man and learn from him the art of the game and the art of being a successful golf professional. The arrangements have now been made and the boy has started his career. He is doing all this as the result of government aid. This serves him well and also the professional who has taken him on. It makes me think too that any young man today who intends to take up golf as a career should first realize that it is not a get-rich-quick process which some of them seem to imagine, but a definite process of learning, working and eventually conquering. Here again is an opportunity for an American business man to open a school for would-be professional golfers and run it much in the same line as a theatrical agency, drawing his per-centage from the successes that he turns out.

Hard working authors like myself have to pay our agents for representing us! So I do not see why such an arrangement between professional and his agent should not work very advantageously for both sides.

I think all clubs will have to make closer tie-ups with schools to help solve the caddie supply problem.

MACHINERY MAINTENANCE is an ever-persistent problem. Breakage occurs in spite of the best care and management, and prompt attention with adequate repair knowledge is required. Unfortunately, most of us are not mechanics, but the use of a wrench and an oil can will go a long way toward keeping machinery in a good state of repair. A knowledge of motors, electric wiring, mower sharpening, welding and other technical machine jobs is helpful.

19 LABOR AND WAGES: Not the least of the problems existing on the golf course are those caused by shortage of labor or inequalities existing in wages paid to golf course employees. It is often true that caddies, kitchen help or waiters make several times the income that do the regular golf course maintenance employees. Naturally this is reflected in worker attitudes, and it becomes a labor-management problem for the greens superintendent. Some method of equalizing wages for work of equivalent categories appears to be the only solution.

PUBLIC RELATIONS: The golf course superintendent often needs to be a diplomat when dealing with club members. Relationships and personalities should be studied carefully, and the course superintendent at all times should reflect his best behavior toward the club members. The ability to swallow a certain amount of pride is an excellent characteristic, irrespective of the type of work being done, and in the long run it is bound to pay dividends. The superintendent should, by all means, listen to complaints with an open mind and from time to time take these to his green-chairman for advice and counseling.

RNOW-HOW and SUPERVISION. Last, but not least, there is an ever continuing need for more education on subject matter, labor relationships, and human psychology. The golf course superintendent needs to be capable of developing projects which meet the needs of the golf course and which are acceptable to his green-chairman, and if need be, to the members of the club. In order to do this, he must be well fortified with factual information on the subject of the moment. In supervising employees he must be fair and honest with them and capable of appreciating and understanding their problems. He should take the time to evaluate employees at regular intervals, pointing out to them their good points as well as their faults. Frank evaluations mean better relationships all around.

#### Wartime Invention Controls Athlete's Foot

With millions of men freshly returned from the fighting zones, a widespread epidemic of athlete's foot is threatened, reports an official of the U.S. Navy Bureau of Medicine and Surgery. "War conditions favored athlete's foot infection. Men had to go days, at times, without remov-ing their shoes. In most of the Pacific area, intense humidity, which fosters the fungi, prevailed. Despite all efforts at sanitation, both Navy and Army doctors found fungi infections a problem," states this official.

According to Professor Fred. D. Weidman of the University of Maryland, "Athlete's foot ranked second among all causes of hospitalization of servicemen in the United States."
