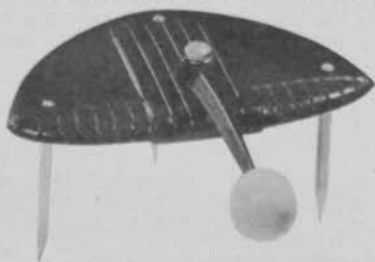

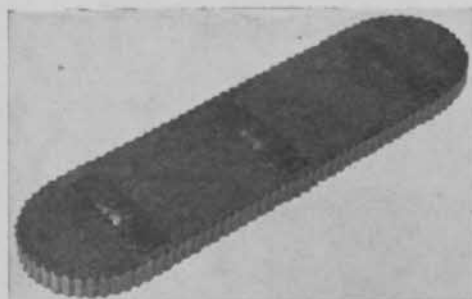

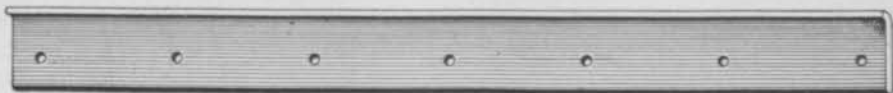

DISTANCE LIGHT FOR RANGES

Northern Golf Co., 3441 N. Claremont Ave., Chicago, is getting favorable comment on their 24-inch light for illuminating the area from 175 yds. up to 300 yds. from the driving range tee line. The light, which comes complete with a 2,000 watt bulb, gives best results if mounted at or near the center of the tee line, 18 to 20 ft. from

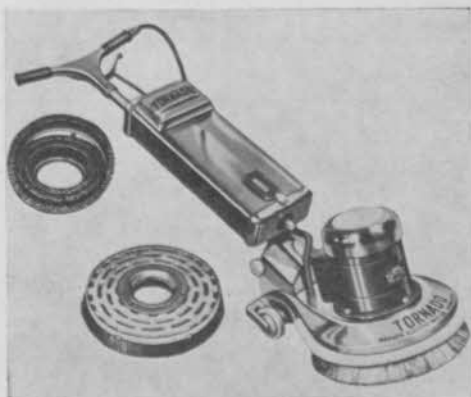


ground. Many range owners find that after setting up their lights they have a blind spot out about 175 yds. where ball is obscured by darkness as it falls to the ground at the end of its flight. The Northern distance light blends in with the shorter range lighting rather than cutting a sharp search-light type of beam. Its illumination keeps skied balls in plain sight. One such distance light at the center of the tee line serves to concentrate the player's aim and in most cases is sufficient if short range lighting is properly handled. 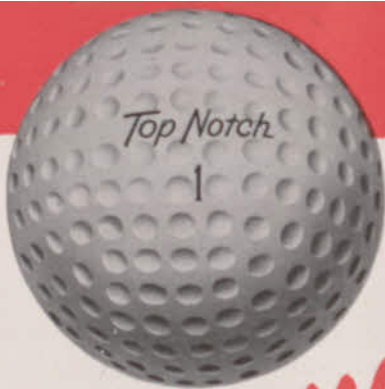
