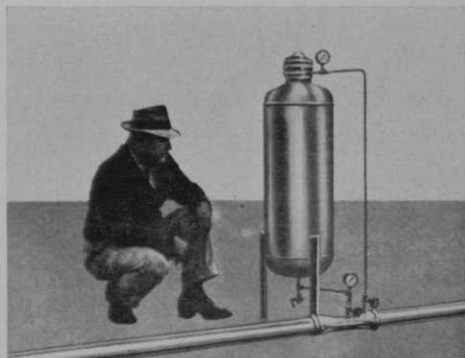

reach of eight feet and a 10-foot digging reach behind the tractor with a 140-degree swinging arc. The bucket, Sherman explained, can be raised high enough to load any standard size dump truck.

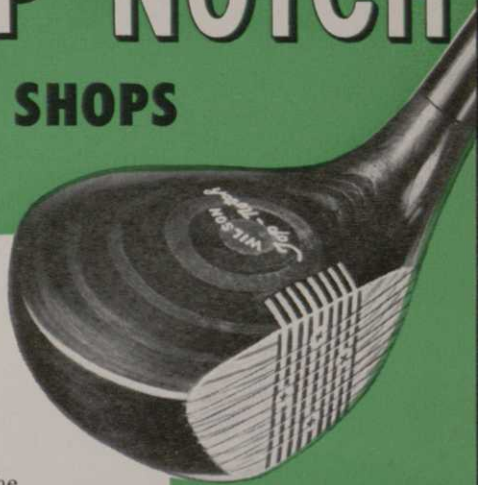
