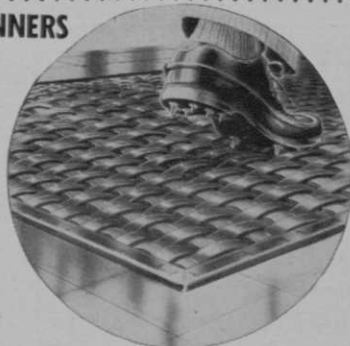

Course Management that Saves Money

Frank Dinelli, supt., Northmoor CC (Chicago dist.), makes some observations that are endorsed by other superintendents who manage their courses with the same excellent results and economy Frank shows at Northmoor.

He says:

"Even in periods of labor shortage it's very doubtful that a man in charge of a first class course can afford, for the good of his job, to go around operating machinery. When he does that he's liable to find himself tied to one detail while something urgently important is developing elsewhere on the course.

"What makes the superintendent of most value to his club is keeping his trained eyes on all parts of the job. In the summer when school is out he should be able to train high school or college lads to properly handle routine work and place them where an experienced worker can advise and help the youngsters, so the superintendent can get around the course supervising every activity.

"The sudden development of disease or insect threats must be attended to without delay and if a superintendent is devoting

himself to routine chores that can be done by day labor he is not managing himself in a way that gives his club fullest value from his services.

"His chairman and other officials know that in their businesses they don't see the chief engineer or the sales manager folding the mail and licking the stamps; if they're doing that something is wrong in the organizing and operating of the business. When they see the superintendent of a heavy investment in golf plant running a mower the business executives might well be inclined to think that if that's the biggest work the department head can find to do the whole job can't be too exacting.

"Doing detail work is a hard habit to break with some men who are in charge of good golf courses. They'd sooner do the work themselves than try to train somebody. Consequently they're at one place on a course for hours when they should be getting around.

"A summer like this one we've been having, with the necessity of constant expert vigilance on all parts of the course, really is a disguised blessing in reminding the superintendent he's expected to be everywhere at once so he'll keep ahead of trouble.

"There's another point that is emphasize-

ing the superintendent's value as a practical expert and that's the dosage of chemical treatments. In exchanging experiences with other superintendents in the Chicago district I've been impressed by the fact that, in some cases, dosages higher than the manufacturers' recommendations give complete and safe control whereas the recommended dosages may give such inadequate control that they really don't do the product justice.

"Determination of the correct dosages for the conditions is a delicate and important problem. Sometimes even the minimum recommended dosage may be too strong. But often I've seen that recommendations made with a view to accenting the economy of a product actually work out to be an extravagance because the product in the applied amount doesn't do the job. Twice the money spent to get complete control safely is economy over a sum spent in getting disappointing results."

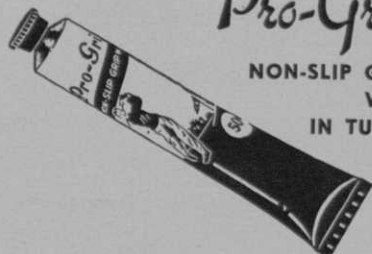

connection which formerly required the use of three or four.

These new fittings are quickly joined in the same manner as previously used for insert couplings. Sections of pipe can be cut to desired length with an ordinary hand saw and fitting inserted. Stainless steel clamps are tightened over the pipe and fitting to draw the pipe down onto the serrations of the insert to assure a positive, leakproof joint. Only tools required are saw and screwdriver, and connections can be completed in less than two minutes.

When Carlon flexible plastic pipe is to be joined to a metal fixture or a previously installed metallic system, an insert adapter is used. One end is screwed onto the metal threads, and then the plastic pipe is slipped over the serrated end and clamped securely. Adapters employ I.P.T., which mate with standard female threads. PORTABLE GENERATOR SAVES IN COURSE MAINTENANCE

Those hard-to-get-at jobs in course maintenance that generally can't be handled with machinery run up maintenance costs to a dizzy height these days, but the members insist on fine grooming of a course.

"Chick" Adams, pro-supt., Sioux City (Ia.) CC found one of the answers with equipment that more than paid for itself in a season's use.

Adams says:

"We had a serious golf course maintenance problem at our club. First, we had trouble locating labor, and second the wages for the men we could locate exceeded our budget.

"To help solve our problem, the club purchased a Winco engine-generator with a 'Speedy-Shift' wheelbarrow base. Then we purchased a Stanley electric grass shear. These shears and the Winco generator are taken around the course to trim around trees, bridges, creek banks, steps, retaining walls and around the club driveway and swimming pool.

"Before we used the Winco generator at my club, which is 18 holes, it took four men twice a week to trim up the course at a cost of approximately \$250 a month, or about

\$1250 a season. But now with our new generator and grass shears, it takes one man only once a week to do the complete job at a cost of only \$160 a season—a clear saving of over \$1000 a year which not



only pays for the Winco generator and the shears the first season, but earns \$500 for the club, to boot.

"The club grounds not only look better, which everybody likes, but there are far fewer complaints about balls lost in the rough which can't be found."

He is a highly successful and sound pro shop merchant too.

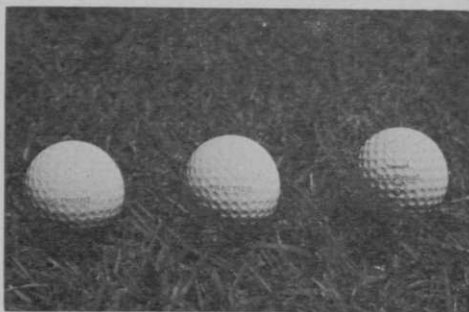

St. Louis dist. pros doing wise job of working together to supply members with what one pro may not have in his shop but another has in stock . . . Telephoning keeps the pros' collective inventories large and the boys aren't cutting each other up on sales.

Illinois Women's Golf Assn. did outstanding job with its program for its Amateur Invitation state championship at Aurora (Ill.) CC June 23-28, and "Illiniwek" at Soangetha CC, Galesburg, Ill., Aug. 5-7 . . . 3-day medal play championship and junior girls' amateur championship included in Illiniwek . . . Mrs. A. K. O. Cochran headed committee that assembled interesting editorial content and sold advertising space . . . IWGA also runs Victory tournaments at its members clubs to finance Swing Club programs at vet hospital golf courses, establish Evans scholarships, provide polio-Respiraid rocking beds to hospitals and contribute to American Cancer Society . . .
